Notice of overnight closure of BBP exit on to Northway Island, 28 and 29 November 2022

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are being carried out by a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons, known as LM. In your area, we are working near the A452, A45 and M42, which surround the site of the future HS2 Interchange Station.

We're improving the local road network

Since 2017, we have been remodelling and improving sections of the existing road network in the area and creating new routes on HS2 land. These road improvements will ensure that when the future station is operational, the local road network is fit for purpose. Upon completion, a new T-junction will replace Northway Island. A new 'longabout' is already in operation outside the Holiday Inn Express NEC, on the way to the National Exhibition Centre (NEC).

We started the creation of the new T-junction outside Birmingham Business Park in April 2021. To complete the final stages of the works, we need to close the Birmingham Business Park exit on to Northway Island overnight for two nights, on 28 and 29 November 2022.

We'll be installing an overnight closure on 28 and 29 November 2022

We will install temporary, overnight closures of the Birmingham Business Park exit on to Northway Island from **8pm on 28 November to 6am on 29 November and 8pm on 29 November to 6am on 30 November** (see map on page 2).

During the overnight closure, Birmingham Business Park's exit off Northway Island will be closed. The entrance off Northway Island and the entrance and exit to the Park via Progress Way off the B4438 will remain open.

No other local routes are affected by this work.

Duration of works

From 8pm on 28 November to 6am on 29 November 2022, and from 8pm on 29 November to 6am on 30 November 2022.

What to expect

A temporary, overnight closure for two nights, of the BBP exit onto Northway Island.

Our contractors may be on site up to an hour before and after those times to set up and close down the site.

What we will do

Keep all sites safe and secure.

Leave the area in a tidy state when works are complete.

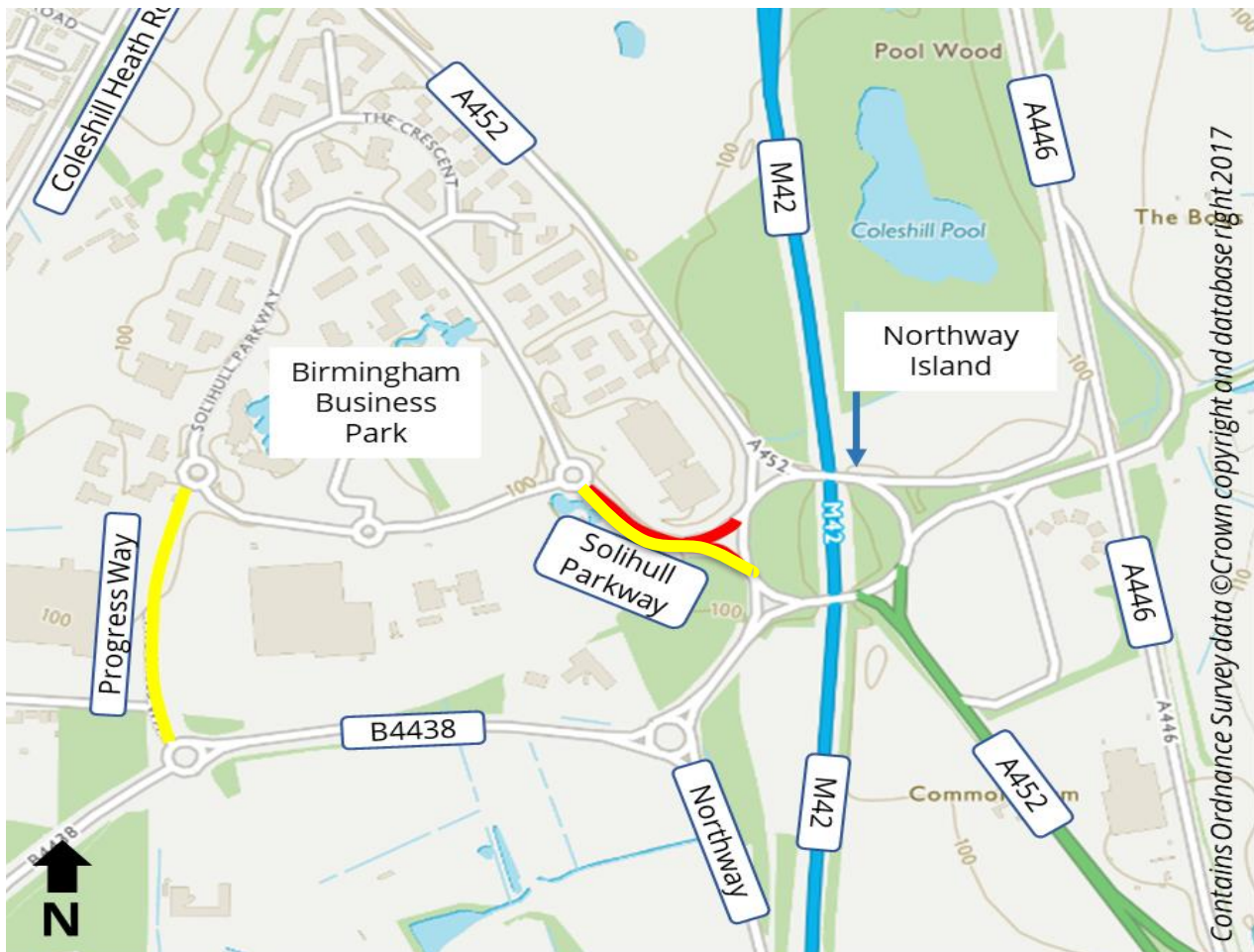


Location of temporary overnight BBP exit closures on 28 and 29 November

The map below outlines the location of two temporary, overnight closures of the BBP exit onto Northway Island on the 28 and 29 of November 2022. Access will be retained via the Progress Way entrance and exit, and the Northway Island entrance to Birmingham Business Park.

Key:

-  = closed Birmingham Business Park exit off Northway Island
-  = accessible Birmingham Business Park entrance and exit off the B4438, and entrance off Northway Island.
