High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Working on behalf of HS2 Ltd, Balfour Beatty is carrying out fencing works on Wood End Lane, Lichfield.

What are we doing

Ahead of the main highway improvement works on Wood End Lane and the junction with A515, we will be creating an access point opposite Baskerville House on Wood End Lane and installing new wooden post and rail fencing along the carriageway.

The access point will require the installation of two gates within the fence line, levelling up the ground and then surfacing with stone. This will allow our workforce entrance into the field to complete the fencing works. We have some further fencing work which can utilise an existing level entrance point.

To safely complete the fencing work, we will require lane closures with two-way traffic lights on Wood End Lane between A515 and Watery

We will inform people of any changes in advance.

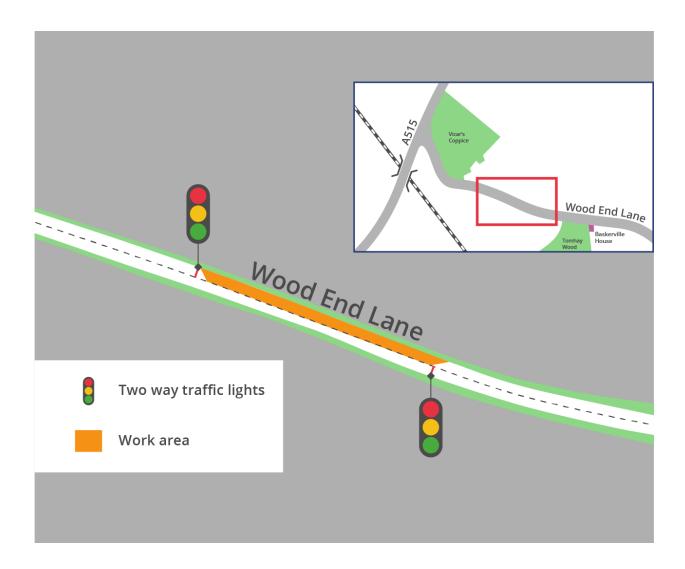
