



Road Closure – Frith Hill South Heath Leg

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. This is a notification to inform you of some works on Frith Hill, South Heath Leg, that will require a road closure at off peak hours.

What are we doing?

We will be excavating two trial holes in the highway (where the previous Weights and Measures gym was located) to survey utility services in the road. To do this, our operatives will be working in the road. We need to close the road to ensure the works can be carried out safely. Barriers will be used to make the surrounding areas safe and will be visible.

How will this affect you?

Frith Hill South Heath Leg will be closed to traffic in both directions from 14 to 18 November. To minimise disruption, the work will be conducted during off peak hours between 9.30am – 3.30pm. Outside of these hours the road will be fully open.

Diversion route signage will be in place. See map on page 2.

What about pedestrians?

The footpath will remain open to pedestrians as the excavations will be safely fenced off.

Has this closure been approved?

Yes. Align have obtained consent from the local consenting authority, Buckinghamshire Council, to carry out these works. A permit has been granted.

Duration of works

A road closure on Frith Hill, South Heath Leg, from 14 to 18 November during off peak times: 9.30am to 3.30pm.

What to expect

Road closure on Frith Hill South Heath Leg with a fully signed diversion route via Chesham Road, B485 and Kings Lane.

What we will do

Reopen the road as soon as possible. Maintain pedestrian access via the footpath.

Inform local Parish Councils, village associations and schools.

Ensure any impacts on residents are kept to a minimum during these works.

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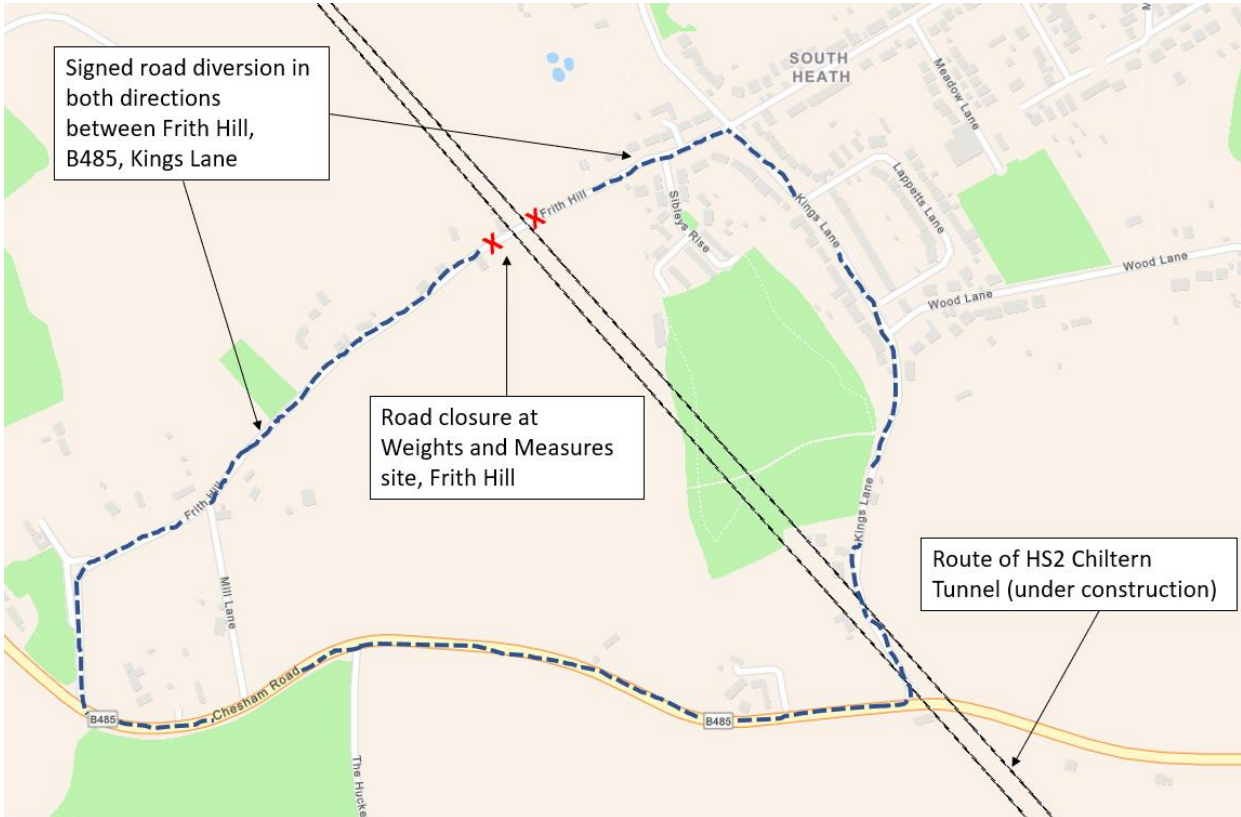

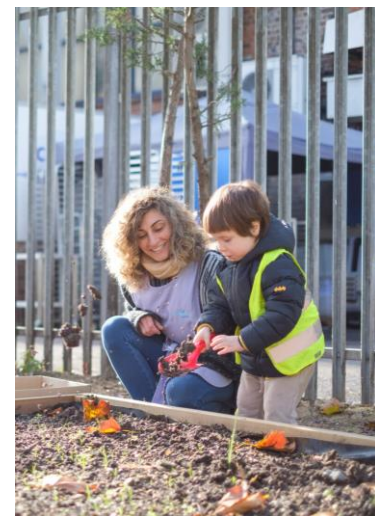
About our Community and Business Funds
