High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

Works planned on Lynwood Road

From 9 to 20 January 2023 we will be carrying out a series of ground investigations on Lynwood Road. The surveys will take place between 8am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturdays.

The ground investigations will consist of digging a temporary trench to confirm the location of utilities under the road surface. The investigations will help us to understand and aid the design of the new railway and the best ways to protect or divert any utilities during construction.

How this might affect you

To ensure the safety of the public and our staff, temporary changes will be in place on Lynwood Road. We will have a temporary partial road closure in place for the duration of these works. A clearly signed diversion route will be in place along

Access for residents will be maintained at all times. You may need to wait for a short period of time to allow for a safe route.

Partial road closures on Lynwood Road from 9 to 20 January 2023

To help us maintain traffic flow on the road network, we have agreed the following diversion route:

Vehicles travelling south on Lynwood Road will be diverted onto Brunswick Road and then Western Avenue.

Vehicles travelling north on Lynwood Road will be diverted onto Western Avenue and then Brunswick Road.

Access to businesses and homes within the road closure will be available at all times.

About our Community and Business Funds
