What we are doing

We wrote to you in October to inform you of extended hours for grouting works at our Mandeville Road site. Grouting is Jetting cement into the subsoil to improve the stability of the foundations. A link to that notification can be found here.

These works are progressing well and will be complete by **18 December 2022**. We are currently undertaking these works from 8am to 10pm Monday to Friday, 8am to 6pm Saturday and 8am to 5pm Sunday.

In addition, from **12 to 23 December 2022**, we will be adapting the lower platform works area in preparation for the next phase of our works, which will be bored piling. A section of the current piling platform requires removal which will involve breaking out a concrete base slab.

These works will take place during core working hours, Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 1pm.

We will install acoustic barriers to reduce the noise impact of these works.

We would like to apologise in advance for any disruption or inconvenience this may cause. Every effort is being taken to ensure that these works are carried out in the least impactful way. We will ensure that disruption is kept to a minimum.
