



Notice of Wendover Bypass lane closure, and Ellesborough road closure

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain, if you have any questions or enquiries about our work, please contact our Helpdesk to find out more. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2inyourarea.co.uk.

What are we doing?

We will be carrying out a utility survey on Ellesborough Road in preparation for the road diversion, which is due to be operational in February 2023. This will require us to close the road on 11 January.

To reduce the number of deliveries to our sites and maintain a sustainable source of concrete for our works, we have set up our own concrete batching plant at our Wendover Green Tunnel site. These works are to connect the plant to a mains power supply.

This will involve excavating part of the Wendover Bypass to insert a high voltage cable across the road. To complete these works safely we will be closing a section of the bypass for a short period of time.

In preparation for these works we will need to carry out a survey of the ground to check for existing buried utility services in the area.

We will be closing a lane and operating two-way traffic lights on Wendover Bypass to complete these survey works. There will also be a road closure on the Wendover Bypass in February to allow us to carry out these power connection works; details will be communicated in due course.

When will these works take place?

- Ellesborough Road closure Wednesday, January 11
- Wendover Bypass lane closure Thursday January 12

We do not expect the surveys to take longer than 4-5 hours each and we will reopen the road and lane as soon as possible.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control but will be completed on or around the timings specified.

Provide fully signposted diversion.


Manage any noise or traffic impacts.

Where will the road and lane closure be?

The maps below, shows the road closure and diversion route on Ellesborough Road 11 January and the lane closure with traffic lights on Wendover Bypass 12 January.

How will this affect me?

For the dates stated road users a fully signposted diversion route will be provided. We would suggest allowing for additional journey time during this period. Emergency access will still be maintained throughout this period.

What will the Green Tunnel be like?

The Wendover Green Tunnel is an 1185 metre long cut and cover tunnel with two 120 metre long portals at each end. The tunnel will be made up of pre-cast concrete twin arches which will be gradually widened at the end which will dissipate the air as the train enters to avoid a sonic boom effect. The use of pre-cast concrete will reduce traffic and noise impact in the local area.

Once the tunnels are in place they will be completely covered and landscaped to return the area to its natural state.

What will the Ellesborough Road realignment be like?

Ellesborough Road re-alignment is due to be complete in June 2023. The newly diverted road will go around the back of the existing houses on Ellesborough Road and will include a bridge to allow our site traffic to pass underneath.

Bacombe Lane access will be diverted to start from the new Ellesborough Road and the original access point over the Wendover Bypass will be closed.

Will there be any more closures?

There are further road closures planned in throughout 2023 for us to be able to commence the road re-alignment and surrounding works. We will keep you updated and communicate details in due course.
