



Updated notice of Aston Church Road utility works

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new railway in your area.

Minor works at Aston Church Road

We recently told you that we needed to complete a utility diversion along the footpath and embankment at the junction of Aston Church Road and Heartlands Parkway. Unfortunately, we were unable to complete a part of the work safely with a single lane closure. We will therefore now need to return to the area to erect a sign and carry out some final minor works.

These works will now be carried out overnight on Saturday 25 February and Sunday 26 February, between 9pm and 6am.

What to expect

To carry out these works safely we will need to put in place a road closure with a diversion route along a section of Aston Church Road. We will also need to close a section of the south footway and divert pedestrians.

Access to businesses and properties will be maintained throughout our works.

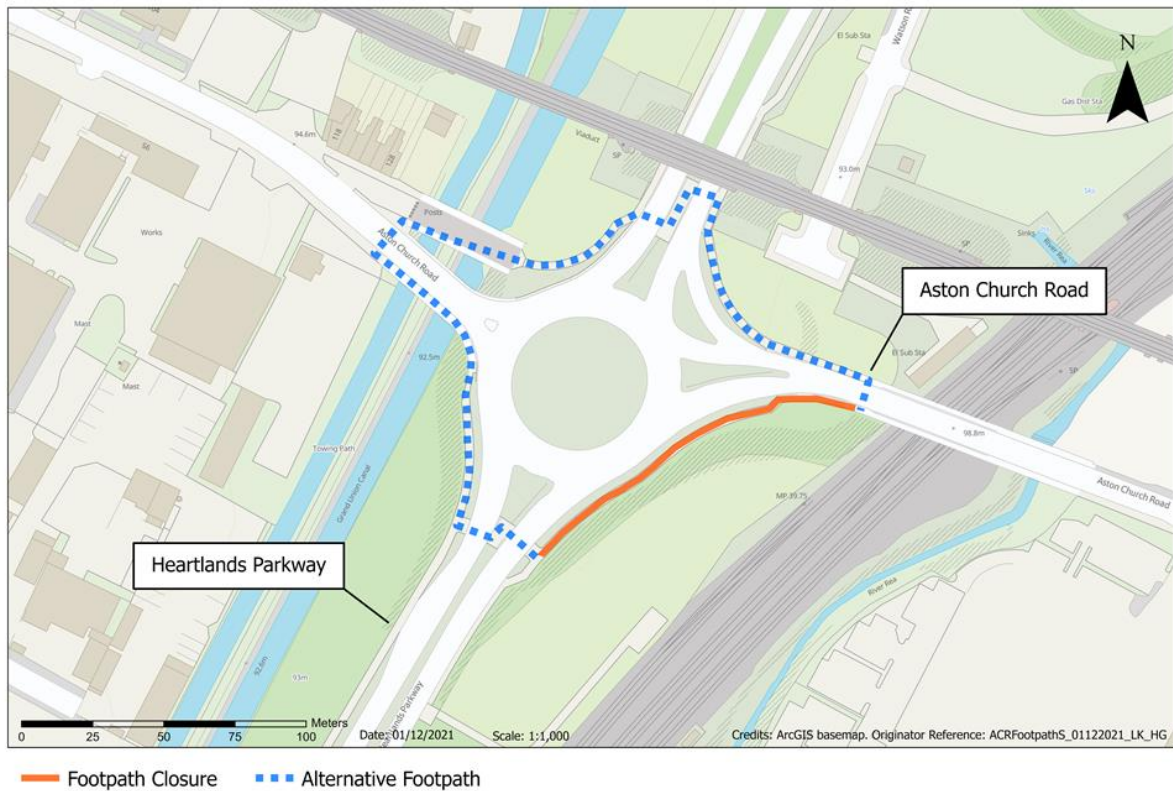

Map showing footpath closure with diversion route. Saturday 25 February – Sunday 26 February.

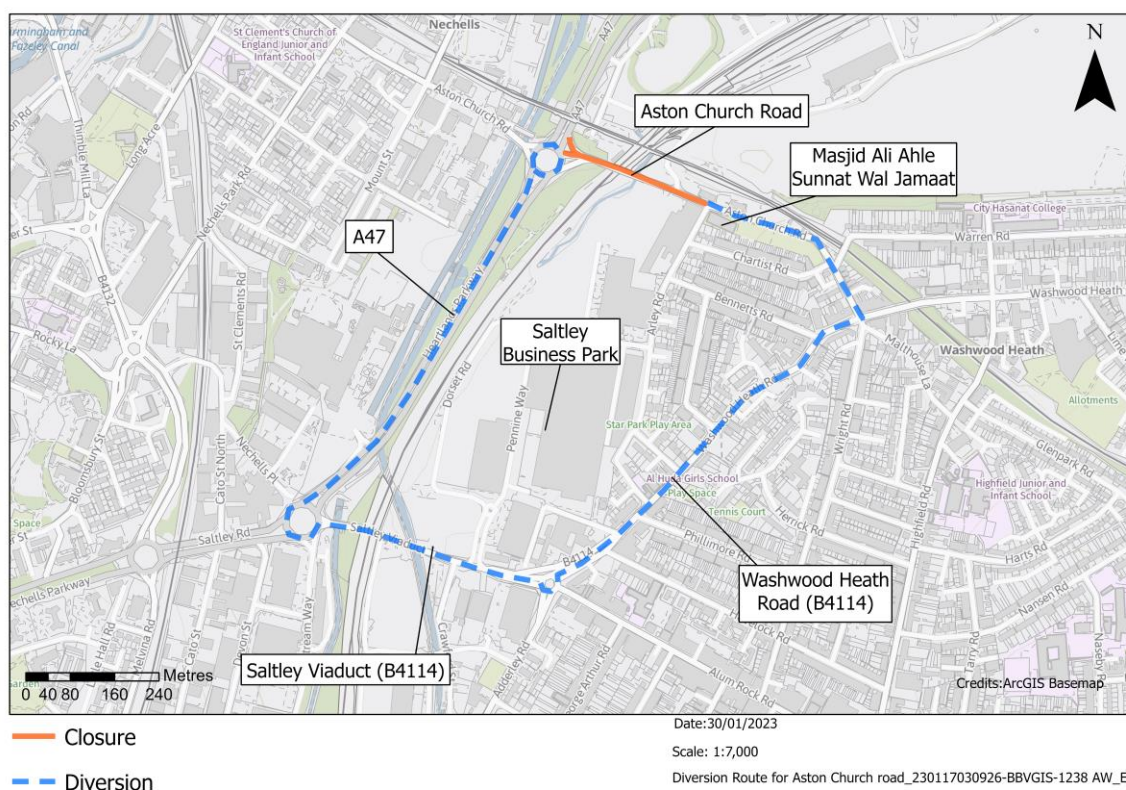
