### What are we doing?

Following the utility diversion work carried out in the autumn of 2022 along Banbury Road in Thorpe Mandeville, in January 2023, Anglian Water will be completing water connection work at the same location.

Anglian Water are carrying out this work on our behalf and will be working directly on the highway. For safety reasons, due to the narrow road width, we need to close this section of road for approximately 1 week.

### When will these works take place?

A section of Banbury Road will be closed 24-hours a day from Monday 23 January to Sunday 29 January 2023 with a diversion route in place.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control, such as weather. This work is also subject to final local authority approvals.

A section of Banbury Road will be closed from Monday 23 January to Sunday 29 January 2023.

24-hour full road closure.

There may be a slight increase in noise from plant and equipment used for these works.

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

Take care to respect the community.

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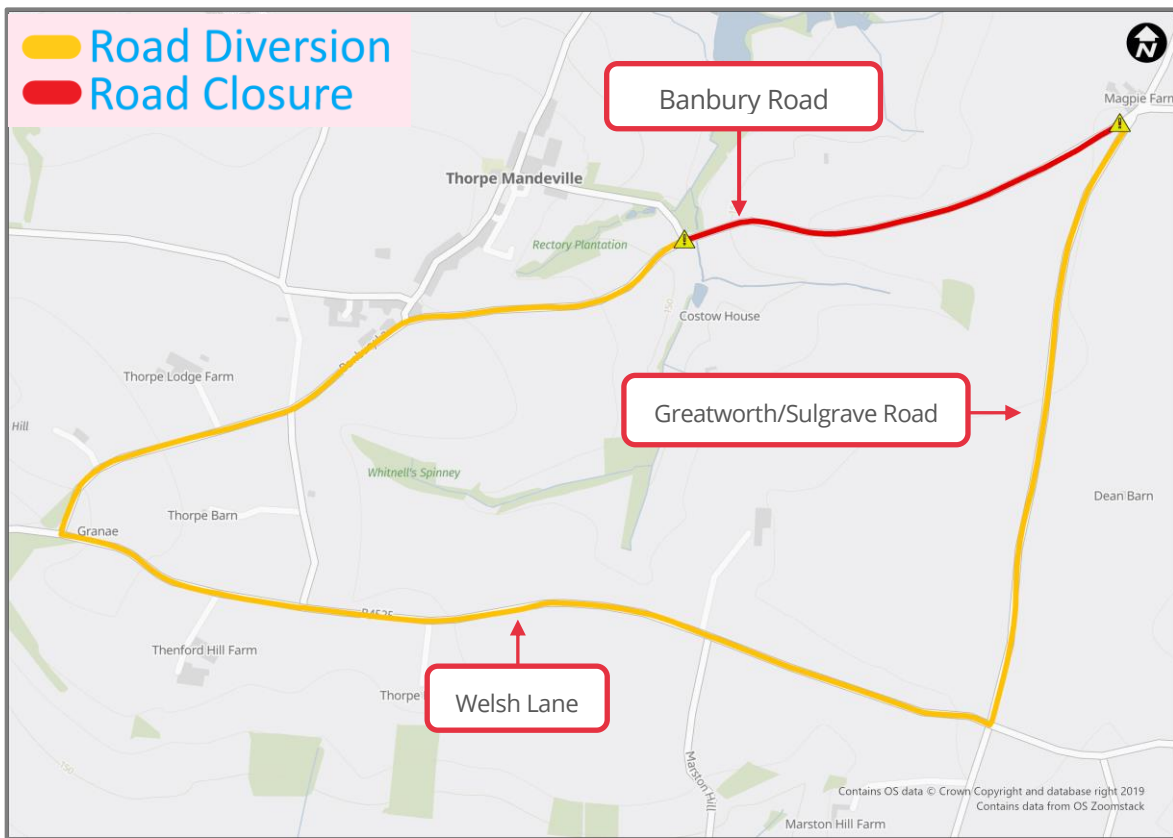
