High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we work within is our priority. What are we doing?

In late December 2022, the existing Gawcott Road/Perry Hill closure will be lifted and the road re-opened for the Christmas period. In early January 2023 we will be closing West Street to commence the diversion and connection of underground utilities.

As our teams work to complete these utility diversions, this section of road will be closed for approximately 7 days.

To carry out these works safely and effectively we will need to put in place a road closure with signed diversions. Our teams will be working on and around the carriageway in open trenches.

From 13 January, Gawcott Road/Perry Hill will be closed again until March 2023. There will continue to be 3-way traffic lights controlling the junction of West Street and Gawcott Road/Perry Hill while we complete utility works.

When will these works take place?

West Street will be closed from Thursday 5 January to Friday 13 January 2023.

There will be no access at all through this section of road during this period.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control, such as weather.

Duration of works

Works will commence and West Street will be closed from Thursday 5 to Friday 13 January 2023.

Works will be carried out within normal working hours, however some additional evening or weekend working may be required when necessary.

What to expect

Full 24-hours a day, 7-day a week road closures on West Street.

Varied activities with both quiet and busier periods.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

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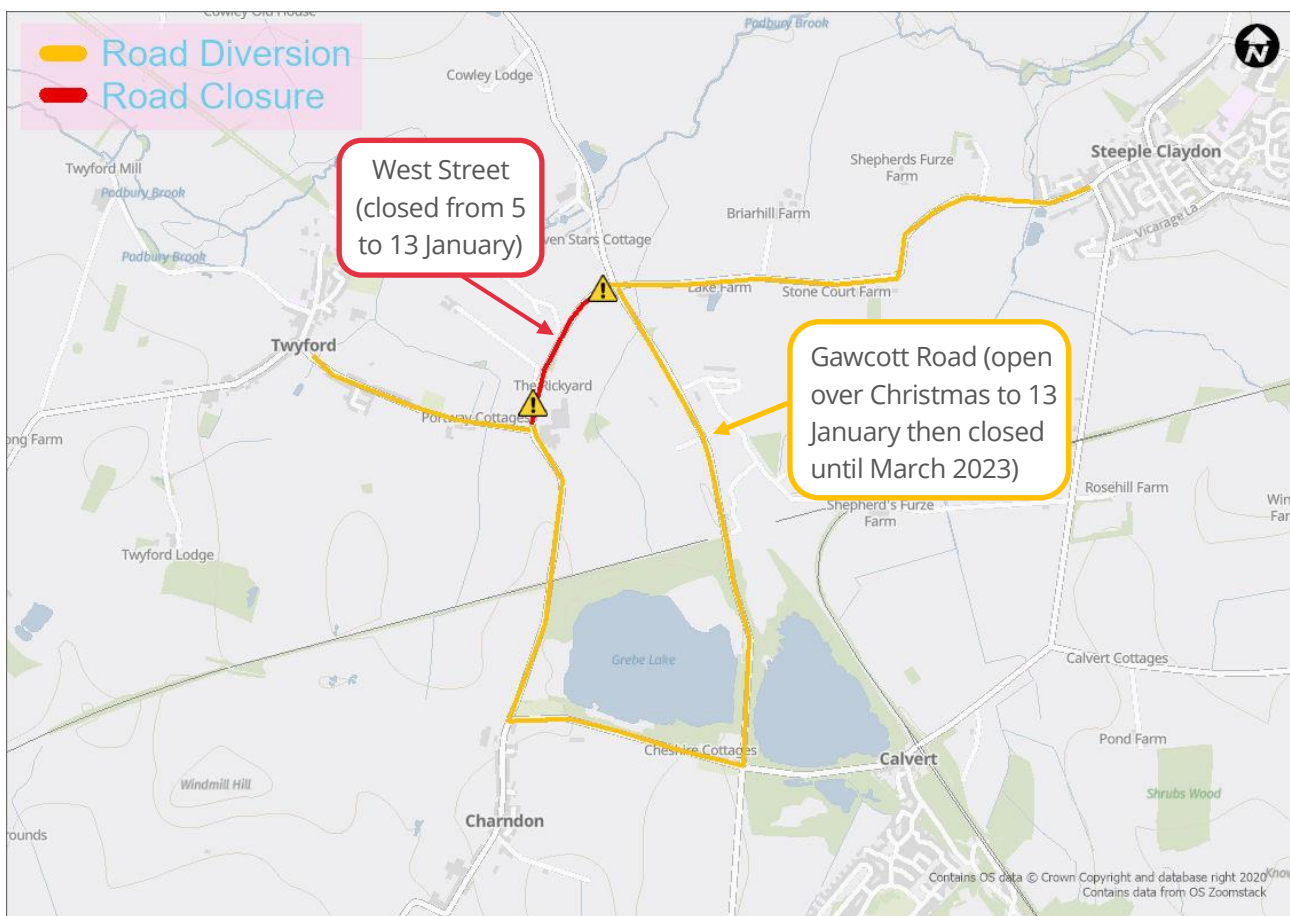
