

### **Updated notice changes to work** on Saltley Viaduct - Birmingham

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new railway in your area.

#### **Saltley Viaduct**

We previously informed you that utility diversion works would be taking place along Saltley Viaduct. These works require a full closure of Saltley Viaduct from 10.00pm – 6.00am, along with local footpath diversions and temporary two-way traffic signals from 9.30am - 3.30pm Monday to Friday.

Unfortunately, these works will take longer than originally expected so we will need to extend the duration of the traffic management. We now expect the two-way traffic signals and pedestrian diversion to be in place until the end of July.

We will also need to continue to close Saltley Viaduct overnight until the end of September 2023 as we will need to divert another utility once these current works are complete.

#### **Pennine Way**

On Monday 3 July, we will be continuing with our works along Pennine Way. For safety reasons these works will require us to use a stop and go sign to manage traffic in and out of Saltley Business Park between 8.00am and 4.00pm. Access will be maintained as usual during these works.

Ensure that our work areas are safe and secure.


