#### Winter 2022/23

This look ahead covers HS2 associated work in Brent and Ealing on our four vent shafts. For information around Old Oak Common station, please see our Old Oak and North Acton look ahead.

The document includes:

- A forward look of construction activities planned in the next three months
- Works to be aware of that will take place in the next 12 months, but may not yet have been confirmed

**Map 1 – Canterbury Works Vent Shaft, Kilburn** 




Some of our work at this site may require extended hours of working. If extended working hours are required, we will send out information to the local community in advance.

Location of works	Proposed duration	Description of works
Location 1 Canterbury Works site	December 2022 to February 2023	<ul> <li>Works at our Canterbury Works site during this period include:</li> <li>Network Rail yard enhancement works including the construction of a new access ramp and site entrance on Albert Road;</li> <li>Works to build the vent shaft including excavation and installation of a sprayed concrete lining; and</li> <li>Works to build adits (horizontal passages below ground) that will connect the HS2 tunnels.</li> </ul>
		These works include excavation and installation of a sprayed concrete lining.

Various locations, Brent	December 2022 to February 2023	We will carry out utility surveys in various locations along the HS2 tunnel route. The surveys tell us what is needed to protect the utility services during construction of the tunnels. We may need to carry out utility protection works in some local areas in Brent.

The surveys will tell us what work is needed to protect the utility services during construction of the tunnels.  We currently expect that utility protection works will be required in some local areas in Brent, including:  Kilburn High Road  Kilburn Lane  Oxford Road  Canterbury Terrace.  We will write to you in advance of any utility surveys or utility works that might impact you.

Location 1 Greenpark Way site	December 2022 to February 2023	<ul> <li>Ongoing works at our Greenpark Way site during this period include:</li> <li>Works to build the main ventilation shaft and satellite shaft including excavation, and installation of concrete segments and a sprayed lining;</li> </ul>

		<ul> <li>Removal of water from the ground as the shaft is constructed; and</li> <li>Network Rail track maintenance works every three months.</li> </ul>

The surveys will tell us what work is needed to protect the utility services during construction of the tunnels. We may need to carry out utility protection works in some local areas in Ealing.

Location 1 Greenpark Way site	Spring 2023 to spring 2024	<ul> <li>Works planned at our Greenpark Way site during this period include:</li> <li>Ongoing works to build the main vent shaft and satellite shaft including excavation and installation of a sprayed concrete lining;</li> <li>Ongoing removal of water from the ground as the shafts are constructed;</li> <li>Works to build adits (horizontal passages) that will connect the HS2 tunnels; and</li> <li>Start of works to prepare for construction of the headhouse building, which will sit on top of the vent shaft.</li> </ul>
Various locations, Ealing	Spring 2023 to spring 2024	We will continue to carry out utility and bridge surveys in various locations along the HS2 tunnel route. The surveys will tell us what work is needed to protect these utility services and bridges during construction of the tunnels. Map 4 - Mandeville Road Vent Shaft, Northolt



Some of our work at this site will require extended hours of working and we will send out information to the local community in advance.

Location of works	Proposed duration	Description of works
Location 1 Mandeville Road site	November 2022 to January 2023	<ul> <li>Works are ongoing to set up the Mandeville Road site for future construction of the vent shaft and headhouse. Works planned for this period include:</li> <li>Inserting cement grout into the ground to improve the stability of the foundations;</li> <li>Construction of a tarmac ramp and piling platform within the site;</li> <li>Network Rail cable and drainage installation;</li> <li>Removal of water from the ground as the vent shaft is constructed; and</li> <li>Installation of bored piling to establish foundations for the headhouse building that will sit on top of the vent shaft.</li> </ul>

Location 2 Carr Road	September 2022 to January 2023	Ongoing utility protection works at the Oldfield allotments on Carr Road. The works planned during this period include:
		<ul> <li>Installation of a sewer lining: temporary 24- hour over pumping system to transfer water and control the sewage flow to ensure the utility services are uninterrupted during construction;</li> </ul>
		Sewer and maintenance cover reinstatement works;
		<ul> <li>Installing a temporary haul road within the allotment's access road;</li> </ul>
		Site compound set up and hoarding installation to enclose our works area;
		Setting up a site compound and installing fencing panels to secure our works on the Network Rail land for the sewer protection works; and
		Completion of sewer lining works in Cherry Gardens.

Location of works	Proposed duration	Description of works
Location 1 Mandeville Road site	Winter 2022 to winter 2023	<ul> <li>We will continue works to build the ventilation shaft in the Mandeville Road site. Works planned during this period include:</li> <li>Installation of bored piling to establish foundations for the headhouse (the building that will sit on top of the vent shaft);</li> <li>Diversion of Network Rail assets to allow for the construction of the vent shaft;</li> <li>Installation of a tower crane to construct the vent shaft;</li> <li>Removal of water from the ground as the shaft is constructed;</li> <li>Construction of a new vehicle site entrance through Badminton Close;</li> </ul>

		<ul> <li>Sheet piling for the basement and satellite shaft; and</li> <li>Excavation of the main shaft followed by concrete lining.</li> </ul>
Location 3 Eastcote	Spring 2023 to autumn 2023	We plan to complete major utility works on Eastcote Lane.
Lane		We will be carrying out gas main installation and protection work in April 2023, following on from our survey works in July 2022.
		We will provide further information to the local community about these works before they start early next year.

# Respecting People, Respecting Places

## Our commitments to you

#### **Informing**

- We will tell you about HS2 works in your area.
- We have local community websites and newsletters with regular information and updates about our work in your area.
- We have local community teams who know your area. They will hold local events and run projects to keep you informed.

#### **Involving**

- We will involve you in opportunities to benefit and learn as we build HS2 including jobs, skills, education, employment and funding.
- We will ask you about the design of specific parts of the railway.

#### Responding

- Our dedicated HS2 Helpdesk is available 24 hours a day, every day of the year, to help with any questions or concerns you have about HS2 or our work.
- If things go wrong, we have a complaints process and a dedicated complaints team.
- An independent Construction Commissioner monitors how we manage and deal with complaints.

#### Consulting

- We will hold formal consultations with you while we seek permission to build Phase 2b of HS2.
- We now have permission to build Phase One and Phase 2a. This means we will only
  formally consult on this part of HS2 when we need permission to do things that fall
  outside the terms of the legislation agreed by Parliament.
