



Location 1 Chalfont St Peter vent shaft site  Location 2 Denham / A412	October 2022 to August 2023 Ongoing until August 2025	<ul> <li>Works at the vent shaft include:</li> <li>Stairs installation inside the shaft;</li> <li>Basement internal works and base slabs; and</li> <li>Connections to the tunnels.</li> </ul> Closure of Tilehouse Lane at its junction with the A412 North Orbital Road. Tilehouse Lane will remain closed to the public until late 2025, while construction work and landscaping for the Colne Valley Western Slopes continues.
	Ongoing until 2025	Permanent traffic lights are in operation to manage our haul road crossing with the A412 at Denham Way. A temporary speed restriction of 30mph has been introduced on the northbound and southbound approach to the crossing point. This will be in place until viaduct construction is complete and the signals are removed.
	March 2021 to March 2023	Rotary piling and sheet piling for the ground and lake piers. This will be followed by concrete pours for the ground pier structures.  Work will start on land next to the North Embankment / Denham Water Ski Club and will progress from north to south across the lakes to Harvil Road in Hillingdon.
	Ongoing until 2025	The launching girder constructing the Colne Valley Viaduct has now crossed the A412 near to Denham Water Ski Club. It is now making its way south towards the River Colne and the Colne Valley lakes.
Location 3 Moorhall Road	Ongoing until 2025	The construction site off Moorhall Road is operational as part of the Colne Valley Viaduct build with traffic signals controlling the haul road crossing at this point. These will be in place to control the flow of construction traffic until the completion of construction.
Location 4 Denham Country Park	Spring 2023	National Grid will start reinstatement work including removal of the temporary track, bridges, fencing, equipment, and tree planting. The footpath near

Flagmore Ditch, which is currently re-opened, will be closed again to allow this work to safely continue.

- We will ask you about the design of specific parts of the railway.

#### Responding

- Our dedicated HS2 Helpdesk is available 24 hours a day, every day of the year, to help with any questions or concerns you have about HS2 or our work.
- If things go wrong, we have a complaints process and a dedicated complaints team.
- An independent Construction Commissioner monitors how we manage and deal with complaints.

#### **Consulting**

- We will hold formal consultations with you while we seek permission to build Phase 2b of HS2.
- We now have permission to build Phase One and Phase 2a. This means we will only
  formally consult on this part of HS2 when we need permission to do things that fall
  outside the terms of the legislation agreed by Parliament.
