



## Notice of road closure, Rocky Lane

### What are we doing?

To allow us to provide a water supply to our Rocky Lane Compound, we need to carry out connection works to the existing Thames Water main that is buried below Rocky Lane carriageway. This will supply the compound and help to reduce the number of vehicles delivering to the site.

Our utilities subcontractor, Clancy, has identified existing cables and pipes already in the ground. The water pipe identified is in the centre of the carriageway therefore to ensure these works are completed safely we will need to implement a full 24-hour road closure for 5 days.

The water connection process involves excavating at the location of the water main and tapping into the main. The water supply to adjacent properties will not be affected during these works. Once complete, the excavations will be backfilled and carriageway resurfaced.

Please note, as we are unsure of the condition the underground pipes may be in, if they require further repair which we cannot undertake on the day, we will need to backfill the excavation and return to complete the works at a later date when we have the necessary mitigation in place.

### When will these works take place?

The road will be closed 24 hours a day between 27 February and 3 March.

These dates are subject to change due to circumstances beyond our control. Should we finish the works early, the closure will be removed.

### Duration of works

Works will take place on the following days:

- Monday 27 February – Friday 3 March

The road closure will be in place for 24 hours a day.

Varied activities with both quiet and busier periods.

A fully signposted diversion route.

### What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

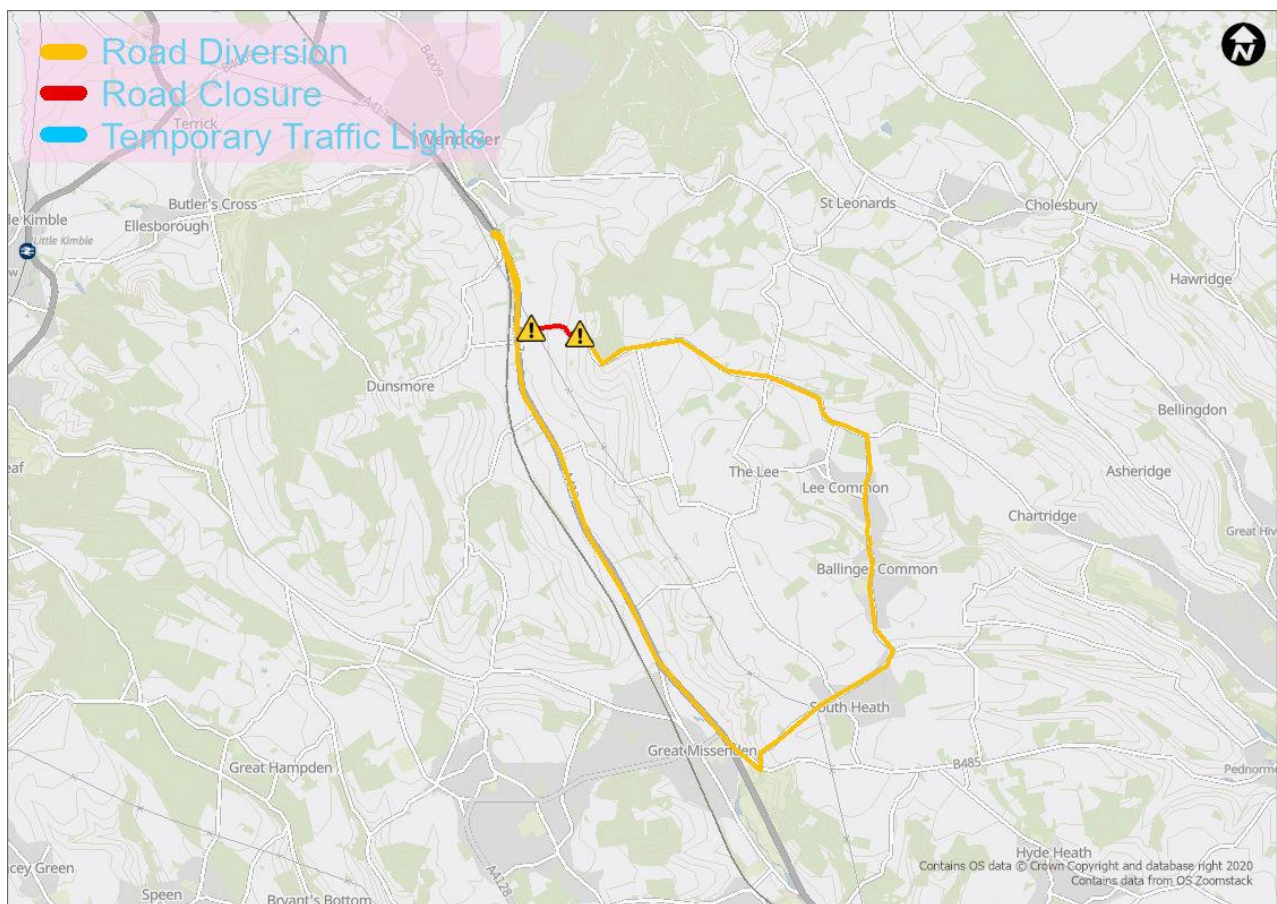

## How will this affect me?

Road users will need to follow the suggested diversion route for access around the closure. We would suggest allowing for additional journey time during this period. Emergency access will still be maintained throughout this period.

## What will you be working on next?

In early 2023 we commenced works on the Rocky Lane bridge, in January we began sheet piling adjacent to Rocky Lane, this will enable us to begin the earthworks phase of construction and protect the earth while the bridge is constructed.

The Rocky Lane diversion and bridge are planned to be operational in 2024 and will eventually carry traffic over the HS2 trace.

## Will there be any more closures?

There may be further closures needed in this area to complete these particular works due to circumstances outside of our control and future closures for other works in this area will be necessary, we will communicate any further information on this in due course.
