### What are we doing?

During March we have needed to close Chiltern Road and Dobbins Lane to carry out watermain maintenance works.

To reduce the number of deliveries to our sites and to maintain a sustainable source of water for our works, we will be establishing a connection to a watermain to supply our Wendover Green Tunnel compound.

To ensure this diversion will not affect the water pressure of Wendover town residences, our subcontractor, Clancy, is carrying out maintenance works in the area.

As the water main access points are in specific locations on Chiltern Road and Dobbins Lane, we have needed to close these roads to ensure both road users and our workforce are kept safe throughout the works.

During our first closure of Chiltern Road in early March we were unable to complete the works on the water main. We are now required to return to complete these works under a further road closure on the junction with Dobbins Lane.

A fully signposted diversion route will be in place throughout the closures and access for market traders to Manor Waste from the corner of Dobbins Lane will be maintained.

## When will these works take place?

- Dobbins Lane closure Monday 20 to Friday 31 March
- Chiltern Road closure Tuesday 11 to Wednesday 19 April

The closure on Chiltern Road will be introduced at around 8am and will be removed as soon as the works are complete. Both closures will be in place 24 hours a day throughout these periods.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control but will be completed on or around the timings specified.
