Notice of road closure, Boddington and Wormleighton

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are following Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on working safely during the pandemic. The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we work within is our priority. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2inyourarea.co.uk.

What are we doing?

As we prepare for the construction of the Banbury Road Overbridge, it is necessary to remove vegetation from the roadside, in the areas where new roads will be built.

By carrying out this work in the winter we will minimise the risks of disturbing nesting birds. Prior to any vegetation removal, an ecologist will complete a detailed survey of the area to be cleared. Any protected species found to be present will be recorded and the vegetation will be left undisturbed with the appropriate buffer zone established.

For the safety of road users and our staff, a section of Banbury Road in Boddington will be closed during off-peak hours for approximately 1 week for this vegetation removal to take place. Depending on the weather and ground conditions, we may make rapid progress and so we may be able to open the road much earlier than planned.

Prior to the above closure, we will also be carrying out some localised vegetation clearance along Wormleighton Road. While these works are carried out, there will two-way traffic lights installed for approximately for 1 week.

When will these works take place?

Temporary traffic lights will be in operation on Wormleighton Road between 8am and 4pm from Monday 6 February to Sunday 12 February 2023.

A section of Banbury Road will be closed from 8am to 6pm, from Monday 13 February to Sunday 19 February 2023 with a diversion in place. This is expected to be the maximum duration and the road may open earlier.

Duration of works

Wormleighton Road will have temporary traffic lights in operation from 6 to 12 February 2023.

Banbury Road will be closed during the day from 13 to 19 February 2023.

Normal Working hours:

Monday to Friday:

8am to 6pm

Saturday & Sunday:

8am to 6pm

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.

What to expect

Varied activities with both quiet and busier periods.

Noise from equipment used for the works.

Localised vegetation clearance to facilitate upcoming works.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

Take care to respect the community.


