

Update: Utility works on Rabournmead Drive

What we are doing

We wrote to you on 17 January 2023 let you know about our plans to carry out the main sewer protection works in Rabournmead Drive Park. These works may now require a later finish on the following dates to allow the sewer pipe connections to cure.

Tuesday 7, Friday 10, Monday 13 and Tuesday 21 February 2023 - 8am to 8pm

The main sewer protection works consist of relining the foul and surface sewer network in Rabournmead Drive Park and replacing maintenance covers.

We will be using water tankers during the works, should we need to flush the sewer system. Your utility services will not be affected.

We will set up a site compound within Rabournmead Drive Park, which consists of:

- Vegetation and shrub clearance to allow clear access to our working
- Removal of existing wooden fence and existing post
- Installing fencing to segregate our work area
- Use of three parking spaces in the adjacent car park to allow entry to our work area

How these works will affect you

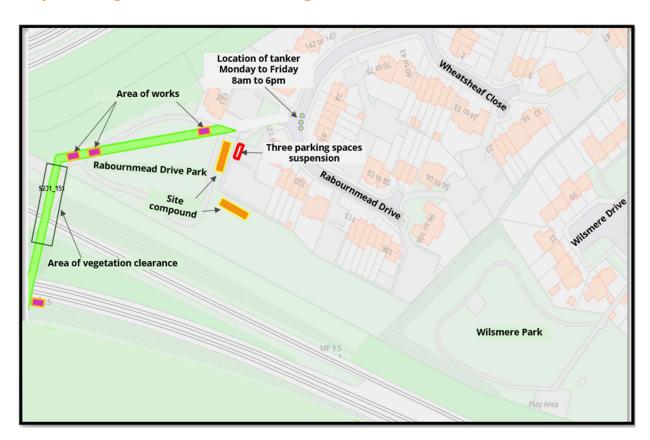
In order to facilitate the sewer lining works, we will position a site working vehicle (tanker) adjacent to the park entrance. We will temporarily position a few cones on the road to segregate the area in which the vehicle will be parked.

We will maintain access to your driveways and the site working vehicle will be removed overnight.

You may hear additional noise during these works. However, we will use noise reducing barriers to surround the work areas when noisy activities are in progress.

We would like to apologise in advance for any disruption or inconvenience this may cause. Every effort is being taken to ensure that these works are carried out in the least impactful way. We will ensure that disruption is kept to a minimum.

Map showing location of sewer lining works



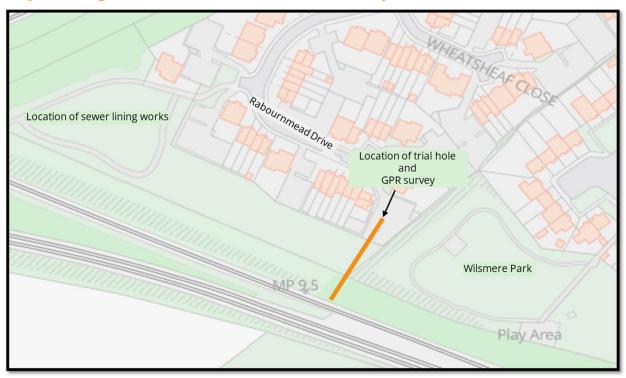
Utility surveys

From 30 January to 10 February 2023, we will be carrying out trial hole surveys in Rabournmead Drive in the field adjacent to the network rail tracks. Please see map below for the works location.

We will be digging trial holes, undertaking ground penetrating radar (GPR) surveys, and investigating the condition of the sewer lining.

These surveys will provide us with information on the condition of the existing utility services and help us to decide how best to protect them.
