

Notice of A413 London Road overnight closures

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain, if you have any questions or enquiries about our work, please contact our Helpdesk to find out more. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2inyourarea.co.uk.

What are we doing?

In order to build the Small Dean Viaduct, we need to temporarily realign a section of the A413.

These works include permanently diverting existing utility services adjacent to the carriageway.

To prepare the area for the beginning of the main utility works, we are required to install crash barriers along the side of the A413 to ensure road users and our workforce are kept safe throughout the duration of our work. In addition, we will also be undertaking some clearance work along the perimeter of the A413.

To enable us to carry out this work we will need to close the road overnight from Monday 6 March – Friday 17 March from 8pm until 6am.

We will require a further weekend road closure to complete the utility diversion works, details of this will be communicated in due course.

The temporary road is expected to be operational from summer 2023 with the Small Dean Viaduct construction being completed in 2026.

When will these works take place?

A section of the A413 London Road will be fully closed from the 8.30pm on Monday 6 March until 5.30am on Friday 17 March. To minimise disruption, we will provide a signposted diversion route.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control.

The road closure will commence on Monday 6 March – Friday 17 March.

Monday at 8.30pm – Friday at 5.30am

Full closures of the A413 overnight for the period between 6 March – 17 March.

Respond promptly to any complaints we may receive and action accordingly.

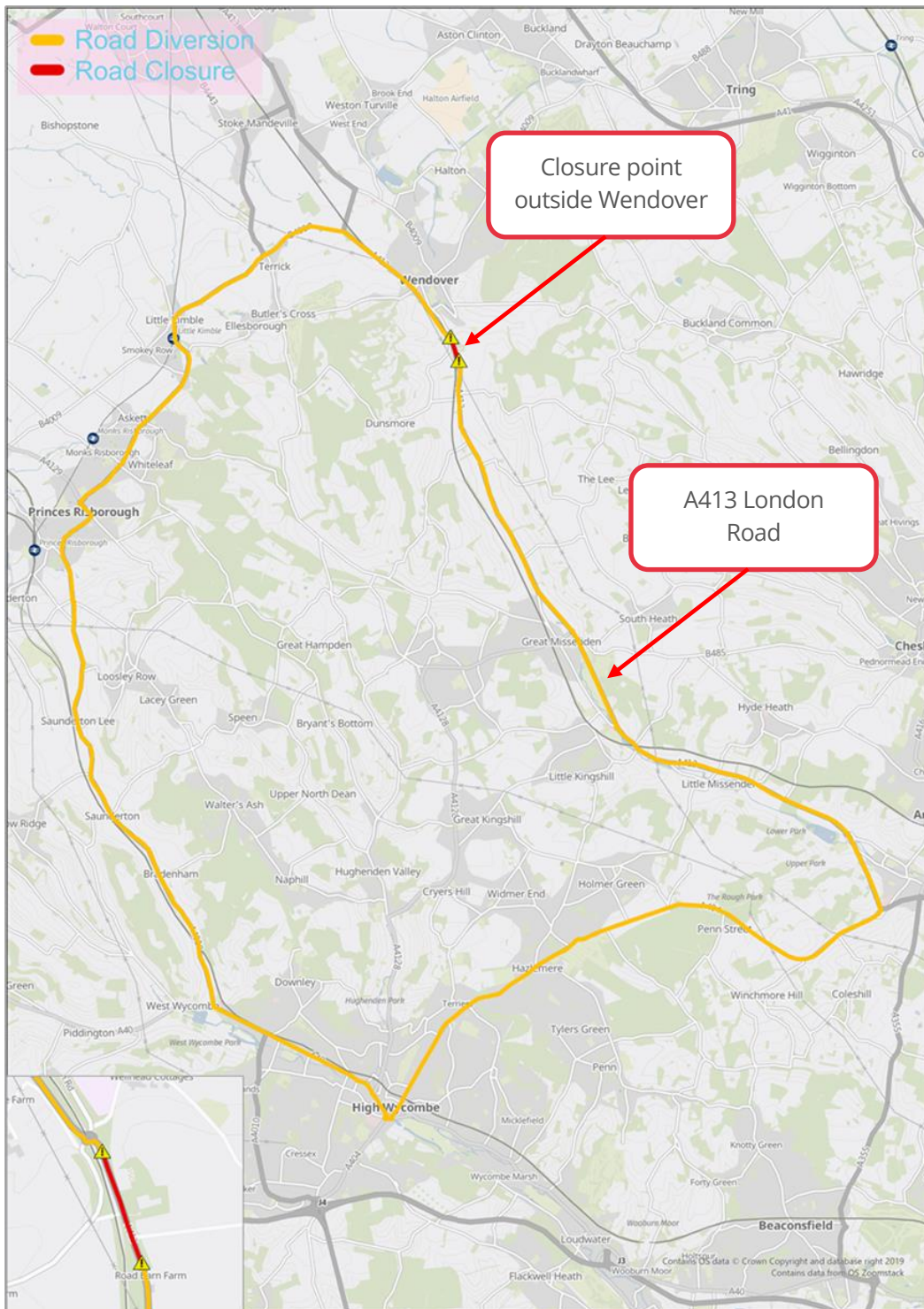
Manage any noise or traffic impacts.

How will this affect me?

For the week stated we suggest allowing extra time for your journey when using the suggested diversion route for access north to Wendover or South to Great Missenden. Emergency access will still be maintained throughout this period.

What will the re-alignment be like?

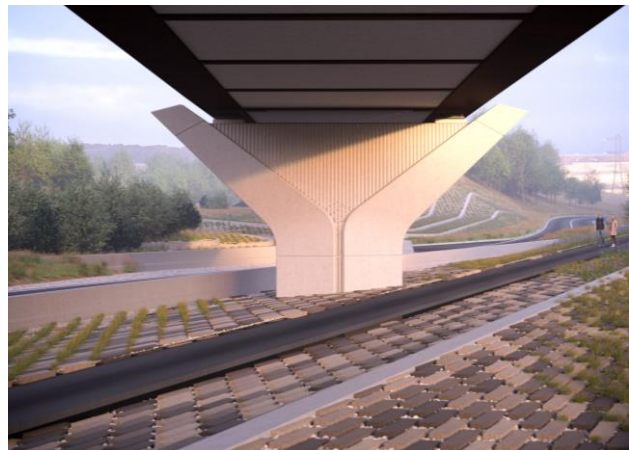
We need to divert the existing road to accommodate the piers of the viaduct that will span this section of London Road at Small Dean. Over the coming months, we will be providing more details about how we will be constructing it, what the impact for you as a road user will be and a programme of the works surrounding it. We will be around the Wendover area with our Mobile Visitors Centre in early 2023 to provide specific drop in sessions for those who want to find out more about the works. Keep an eye of the HS2 website or sign up to receive email notifications for further details.

Will there be noise overnight?

There may be some noise associated with the works but we do not anticipate this to be over our permitted overnight noise levels. We will monitor the works as we progress. All works are subject to consents granted by the local authority to work outside of our normal working hours.

Will there be any more closures?

There are further road closures planned throughout 2023 for us to be able to commence the viaduct and surrounding works. We will keep you updated and communicate details in due course.
