# What are we doing?

In early March, we will be improving traffic flow through Charndon by removing the 3-way temporary traffic lights and pedestrian crossing at the junction of School Hill, Main Street and Steeple Claydon Road now that the pedestrian footpath here has been widened.

These works will include the removal of the temporary traffic lights, stop lines and pedestrian crossing studs. We will also be repainting the road markings at the junction.

In order to carry out these works safely and effectively, a section of School Hill, Main Street and Steeple Claydon Road will be under traffic management for one day. This is for safety reasons, as operatives will be working on and around parts of the carriageway.

We are aware that the temporary traffic lights at this location cause unnecessary disruption to road users now that the safety of the junction for pedestrians has been improved. As such, we have scheduled these works to take place as soon as possible and with a shorter than usual notice period. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.

#### When will these works take place?

A section of School Hill, Main Street and Steeple Claydon Road will be under traffic management during the day on Wednesday 1 March 2023.

This date may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control, such as weather.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.


