What are we doing?

As HS2/EKFB continue to construct the A423 Banbury Road Overbridge, in March will be carrying out vegetation removal and other preparation works along the A423. This work will allow nearby utilities to be diverted later in the year.

Prior to any vegetation removal, an ecologist will complete a detailed survey of the area to be cleared. Any protected species found to be present will be recorded and if required, the vegetation may be left undisturbed with the appropriate buffer zone established.

For the safety of road users and our staff, temporary traffic lights will be installed along section of A423, between Ladbroke and Southam for 3 days. This will be immediately followed by a full road closure during the weekend. We will be working 24-hours a day during the weekend, therefore reducing the impacts on weekday commuter traffic. Wherever possible we will schedule noisy work activity to daytime, but local residents may notice some increased noise throughout this work.

A highway layby, located south of our compound, on the A423 will be closed from April, and will then remain closed for the duration of the overbridge construction.

When will these works take place?

The A423 Banbury Road, between Ladbroke and Southam will have:

- Traffic lights from Wednesday 15 March to Friday 17 March 2023, between 8am and 5pm.
- Road closure from 8pm on Friday 17 March to 6am on Monday 20 March 2023, 24-hours a day.
- Traffic lights may be required on Monday 20 March and Tuesday 21 March until 5pm to complete the work.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control, such as poor weather.

Duration of works

The A423 will have two-way traffic lights from Wednesday 15 March and Friday 17 March 2023.

Road closure on A423 from Friday evening, 17 March to Monday morning, 20 March 2023, 24-hours a day.

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.

What to expect

Traffic lights for 3 days and weekend road closure on the A423.

Some increased noise throughout the weekend.

Access will be maintained for residents and emergency services.

What we will do

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

Take care to respect the community.

Where will the works take place?

The map below, shows the weekend road closure on the A423 Banbury Road and diversion via the A361. The road closure will be in operation from 8pm on Friday 17 March to 6am on Monday 20 March 2023, 24-hours a day. Traffic lights may be required on Monday 20 March and Tuesday 21 March until 5pm to complete the work.

Access will be maintained for residential properties within the closure area, including properties on Kingfisher Drive. Business access will also be maintained for the Warwick House Industrial Estate.
