High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we work within is our priority. What are we doing?

As part of our continued works for the new permanent realignment of Featherbed Lane and the Featherbed Lane Overbridge, we will be completing the tie ins for the temporary diversion of Featherbed Lane, also known as Lane through Fulwell.

Our works will include road surfacing, white lining and the installation of road signage. Once our works are completed, a road safety audit will be carried out before the temporary diversion is open for public use.

Due to the nature of the works, there will be open trenches across the highway and for reasons of safety we will require full road closures, including over the weekend. There will also be noise from large plant and machinery.

After the tie ins are complete, there will also be temporary traffic lights in this location while we build the Featherbed Lane Overbridge.

When will these works take place?

The junction of Church Lane and Featherbed Lane will be fully closed, 24 hours a day, from Monday 25 April to Friday 5 May 2023. Access will be maintained for local businesses and signage on the road will indicate the closure area and diversion.

There will also be traffic management in the form of temporary traffic lights in this location from the end of April and into the summer 2023.

Duration of works

The junction of **Church Lane** and **Featherbed Lane** will be fully closed 24-hours a day from Monday 24 April to Friday 5 May 2023.

What to expect

Full junction closure, where Church Lane and Featherbed Lane meet, to complete the tie ins for the temporary diversion of Featherbed Lane.

Access for businesses will be maintained.

Traffic lights in this location into summer 2023.

Noise from large plant and machinery.

The temporary diversion of Featherbed Lane is expected to be operational this Spring 2023.

These dates may be subject to change, due to circumstances outside of our control.


