Works over Easter weekend in Euston Approaches

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

24 works - day and night - from 7 to 11 April

For safety, we can only carry out works next to the railway when the tracks are not in use. We will work 24 hours - day and night - over the long weekend, to complete works next to the tracks before they reopen. We plan our construction activities to avoid working over the holidays wherever possible but need to make the most of this opportunity to work next to the tracks.

Works in Euston Throat area

We will install hoarding at track-level between our worksite and the railway and continue works to clear the surface of Granby Terrace bridge.

You will be able to see us working on Granby Terrace bridge during the day and night. There may be periods of increased noise as we remove the surface of the bridge. We will take measures to limit the impact of noise, dust and site lighting and will monitor the works closely to ensure we are operating within noise limits. We will also remove the storage containers next to our main site office. We will use a crane to load them on the back of lorries and remove them via Harrington Street. We do not expect these works to be noisy.

Works in Camden Cutting area

In April we will start piling in the narrow section of our worksite just south of Parkway, next to the railway. For safety some of these piles can only be installed when the tracks are not in use.

Over the long weekend, we will install piles during the day and move equipment and material at night in preparation for the next day. You may notice periods of increased noise from the piling rig and excavator. We will monitor our works closely to ensure we are operating within approved noise and vibration limits, particularly when working at night.

We will also carry out surveys of the railway and bridges at track-level within the cutting. We do not expect these works to be noisy.

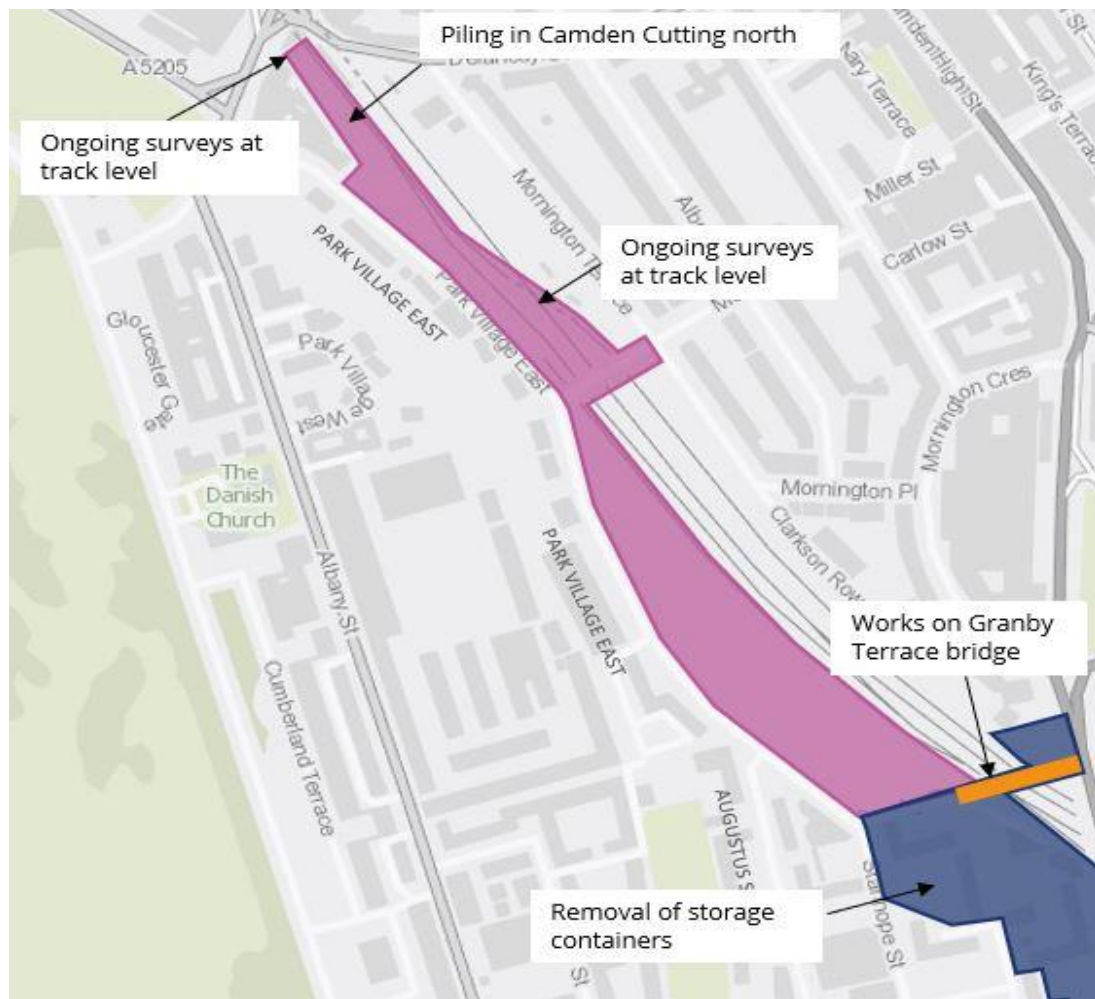
