**Euston Station Easter work**  
**7 April – 10 April**

**Area reference: Euston station – Easter 2023**

**What we are doing and why we need to do this work:**

Further to our last letter in March, I wanted to remind you about work taking place across Euston station over the Easter bank holiday weekend.

During a four-day closure of Euston station between Friday 7 and Monday 10 April, we'll be carrying out the following activities: (Please note that some of the work will be 24hrs a day)

Strengthening the concrete deck above the platforms	Platform 14/15	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Installation of plates, girders, and bolts to support the structure.</li> </ul>
Installing new equipment to help protect the station building from lightning strikes	Platform 14/15 Parcel deck (above the platforms)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Installing 23 earth rods</li> <li>Installing connection earth tape</li> <li>Coring of columns to enable installation of lightning protection</li> </ul>
Recovery of redundant services	Platform 16	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Removing equipment and cabling that is no longer in service</li> </ul>
Demolition	Western edge of parcel deck (above the platforms)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Demolition of parcel deck over P15/16</li> </ul>
Repair to beam	Platform 5-10	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Repairing damaged beam below office buildings.</li> </ul>
Deliveries of materials	Clarkson Row	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Delivery of materials to facilitate the building of a new railway access point</li> </ul>
Enabling work	Clarkson Row	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Construction of trackside elements of Clarkson Row project</li> </ul>
Overhead line equipment adjustments	Euston approach – trackside	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Adjustments to the overhead lines via mobile platforms</li> </ul>

**How this work may affect you:**

Some of the machinery we need to use means some noise is unavoidable. We have made every effort to schedule the noisiest work during the daytime and we'll make every effort to reduce disturbance where we can. We'll put noise barriers up where it is safe to do, use silenced generators and equipment and carry out noise monitoring where needed to ensure that noise levels are kept within agreed limits.

Our staff are regularly briefed on the importance of working responsibly in the local community.

**Changes to train services over Easter:**

The railway between London Euston and Milton Keynes will be closed from Friday 7 to Monday 10 April while vital improvement work is carried out. We're advising rail passengers who are planning to use the West Coast main line, to travel either side of the Easter bank holiday weekend.
