

Amendment to notice of temporary traffic lights on B4455, Fosse Way

Notification



High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

Amendment

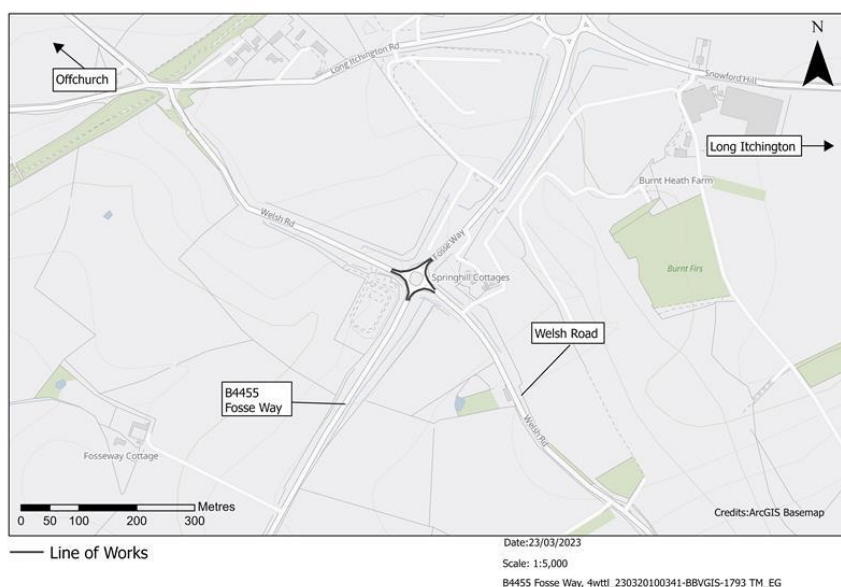
Due to delays with deliveries, the temporary traffic lights on Fosse Way have been removed this week. They will be installed again 26 to 28 April, between 9.30am – 3.30pm.

The work we will be doing

We will be removing and replacing a damaged signpost on the southside of the roundabout at the Fosse Way and Welsh Road junction. Due to high traffic volume, to maintain the smooth flow of traffic, and to carry out this work safely, we need to install four-way temporary traffic lights at the roundabout during the day.

When will the works take place

The works will take place from 26 to 28 April 2023. The temporary traffic lights operating from **9.30am to 3.30pm**. To reduce disruption to traffic, the lights will be switched off during peak hours.



Duration of works

Amended date, 26 to 28 April 2023

Temporary traffic lights will be in operation from 9.30am to 3.30pm on these dates

During peak hours the temporary lights will be switched off

What to expect

Four-way temporary traffic lights and site vehicles

Our workforce may be on site one hour before and one hour after, to set up and secure our equipment

There will be minimal disruption to your journey time
