What are we doing?

This spring we will be carrying out highway work near the junction of Banbury Road and Warwick Road near Boddington. This is one of first stages of joining the existing highway to the Banbury Road Overbridge. Road closures will be required initially, but to reduce highway impacts, much of this work will be completed using traffic lights.

The work will involve the installation of drainage systems and a vehicle safety barrier. It will require the full closure of Banbury Road for 4 days in early May followed by the closure of Warwick Road for approximately 2 weeks. The safety barrier is required for the safety of road users and our staff as the construction area will be near to the road.

Once the drainage and safety barrier are installed, Banbury Road will then have two-way traffic lights for approximately ten weeks while we continue to construct the new permanent highway realignment next to the current road. We are working on construction methods to reduce the impact on highway users, and so these traffic lights may be removed earlier if possible.

When will these works take place?

A section of the Banbury Road will be fully closed, 24-hours a day, from **Tuesday 2 May to Friday 5 May.** This section of road will also have traffic management from Friday 5 May to the middle of July 2023.

A section of the Warwick Road will be fully closed, **24-hours a day, from Tuesday 9 May to Wednesday 24 May 2023.**

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control, such as weather and local authority consent.

Duration of works

A section of Banbury Road will be fully closed from Tuesday 2 May 2023 for 4 days. Followed by traffic lights from 5 May to the middle of July.

A section of Warwick Road will be fully closed from Sunday 9 May to Monday 24 May 2023.

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.

What to expect

A section of Banbury Road will be closed 24-hours a day for 4 days in May.

A section of Warwick Road will be closed 24-hours a day for 16 days in May.

Two-way traffic lights along a section of Banbury Road for into the Summer.

What we will do


Where will the works take place?

Banbury Road from 2 May to 5 May.

Warwick Road from 9 May to 24 May.

To reduce disruption, these roads will not be closed at the same time.
