High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

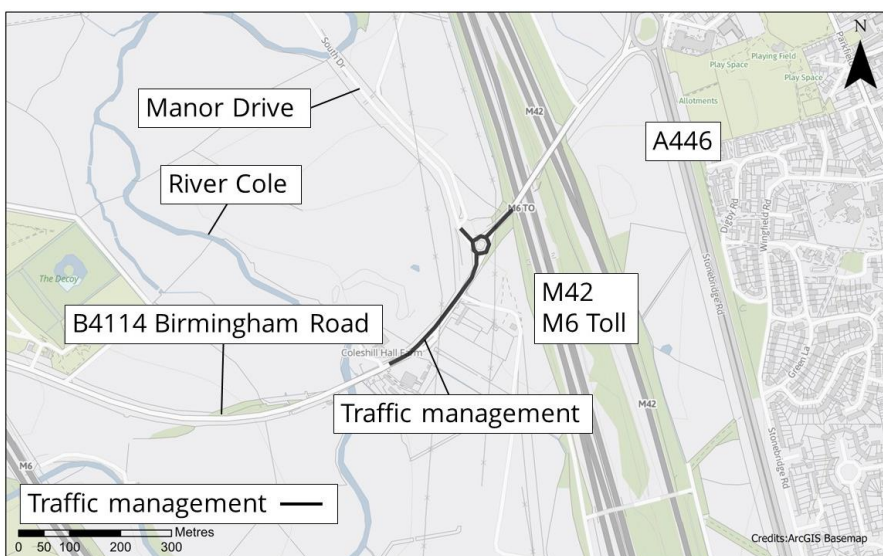
The work we will be completing

We are continuing to prepare for works to construct the Coleshill Viaducts, that will carry the HS2 railway over the existing B4114 Birmingham Road. This includes setting up our works areas and compounds.

Subject to consent, we will widen our existing site access on the south side of the B4114 Birmingham Road and create a fourth arm off the existing B4114 Birmingham Road roundabout. This work will take place from Monday 22 May until Friday 23 June. Our working hours will be 8.00am until 6.00pm Monday to Friday.

Traffic management

To complete this work safely, we will install three-way traffic lights along B4114 Birmingham Road, this will include the roundabout. The traffic lights will be in place from Monday 22 May until Friday 23 June, 24 hours a day. During peak hours the traffic lights will be manually controlled in order to reduce disruption to traffic.



Duration of works

Three-way traffic lights in place along B4114 Birmingham Road from Monday 22 May until Friday 23 June

Traffic management to be in place 24 hours a day throughout this work

What to expect

Works to widen the existing site access and create a fourth arm off the roundabout to take place throughout the traffic management

Working hours for this work to be from 8.00am until 6.00pm Monday to Friday
