High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

Constructing the new temporary diversion of Park Lane

We will be commencing construction of the permanent Capper Lane / Park Lane realignment and Cappers Lane Overbridge. To minimise the impact on road users, while we construct the road and bridge, we are creating a temporary diversion on land next to Park Lane. Once completed we will divert traffic onto the new temporary road which will minimise future disruption and closures of Park Lane.

To enable us to complete works on the new temporary diversion we will close Park Lane so we can install drainage, signage and connect the new road to the existing road surface. We will also undertake utility connection works.

Once we complete the works on the temporary diversion, ensuring it is safe for road users, we will open and divert traffic onto the new road.

When the work will take place

These works will start on Tuesday 9 May to Friday 26 May 2023.

Our working hours will be from 8am to 6pm each day (Monday to Sunday) and the closure will in place 24/7 for the duration of these works.

Our workforce can be on site one hour before and after to set up and secure our equipment.


