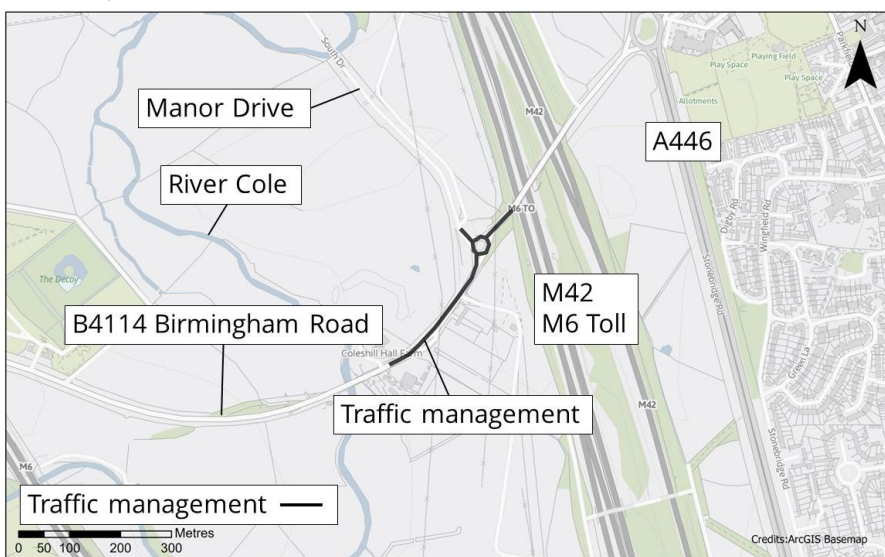
High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be completing

We are continuing to prepare for works to construct the Coleshill Viaducts that will carry the HS2 railway over the existing B4114 Birmingham Road. We previously sent out a notification outlining traffic management that would take place from Monday 22 May until Friday 23 June to widen and create site accesses on the south side of the B4114 Birmingham Road. Due to unforeseen circumstances this work has now been delayed and will be complete in two phases. Phase one will take place from Monday 26 June until Saturday 1 July, to widen our existing site access. We will update further on phase two of the works.

Traffic management

To complete this work safely, we will install three-way traffic lights along B4114 Birmingham Road. This will include the roundabout section. The traffic lights will be in place from Monday 26 June until Saturday 1 July. The traffic management for this work will be from 9.30am until 3.30pm each day.



Duration of works
