What are we doing?

In order to build the Small Dean Viaduct, we need to temporarily realign a section of the A413. We are now starting phase one of this realignment which involves utility diversion works.

Final preparations for these works, will be completed in a series of overnight lane closures beginning on Monday 15 May.

Further closures will be required to complete these works, details of which will be communicated in due course.

We will also be implementing off-peak three-way traffic lights at the junction of Rocky Lane so we can complete drainage improvement works on the verge, this will be for one day.

When will these works take place?

A413 London Road, lane closures will be:

- Overnight only on Monday 15 May to Saturday 20 May – 8.30pm to 5.30am

Three-way traffic lights will be installed at the junction between Rocky Lane and the A413 London Road on:

- Monday 15 May – 9am to 3pm

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control and were correct at time of distribution.

Respond promptly to any complaints we may receive and action accordingly.

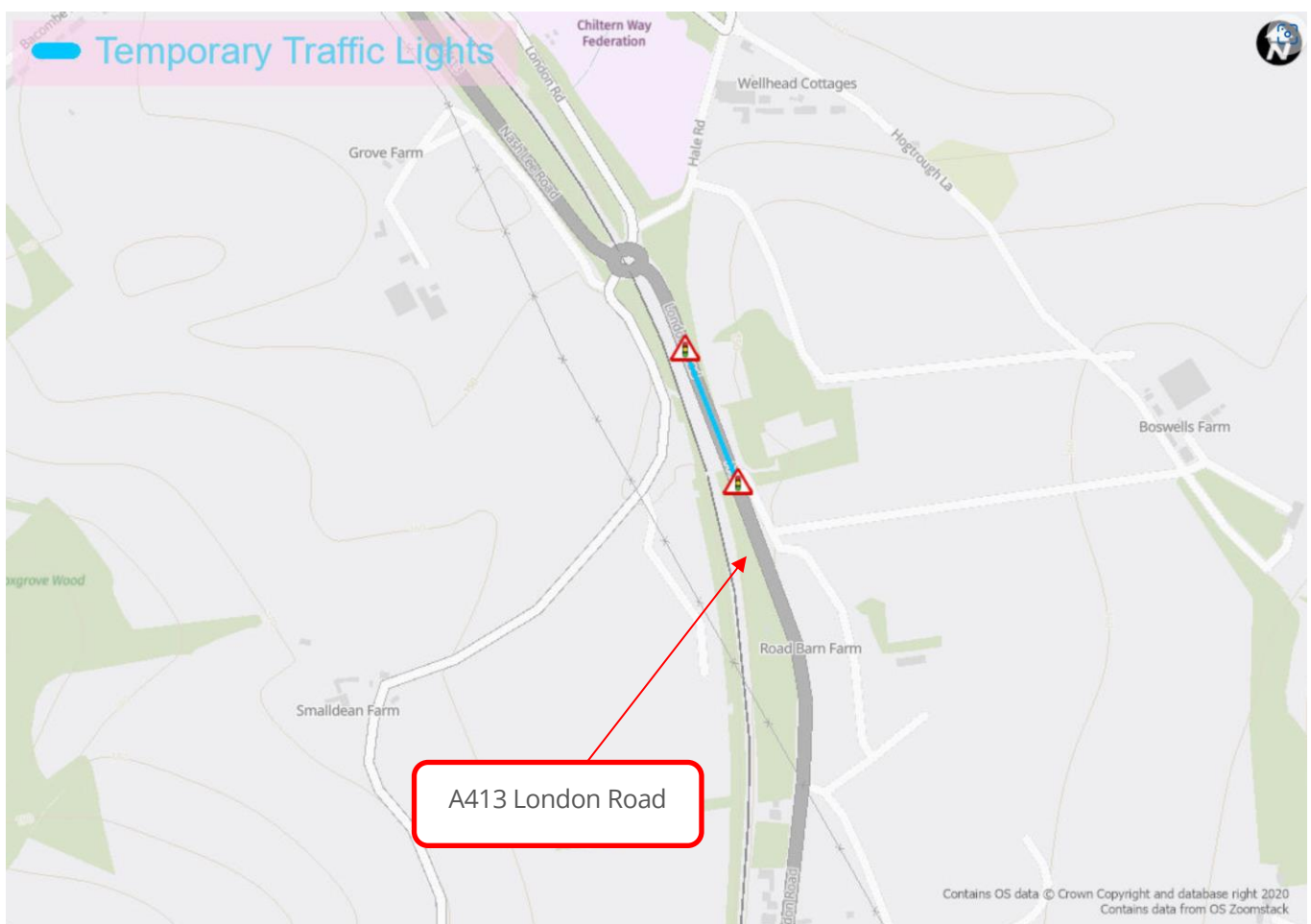

The map below, shows where the lane closure will be from 15 – 20 May overnight only between 8:30pm to 5:30am on the A413 London Road.



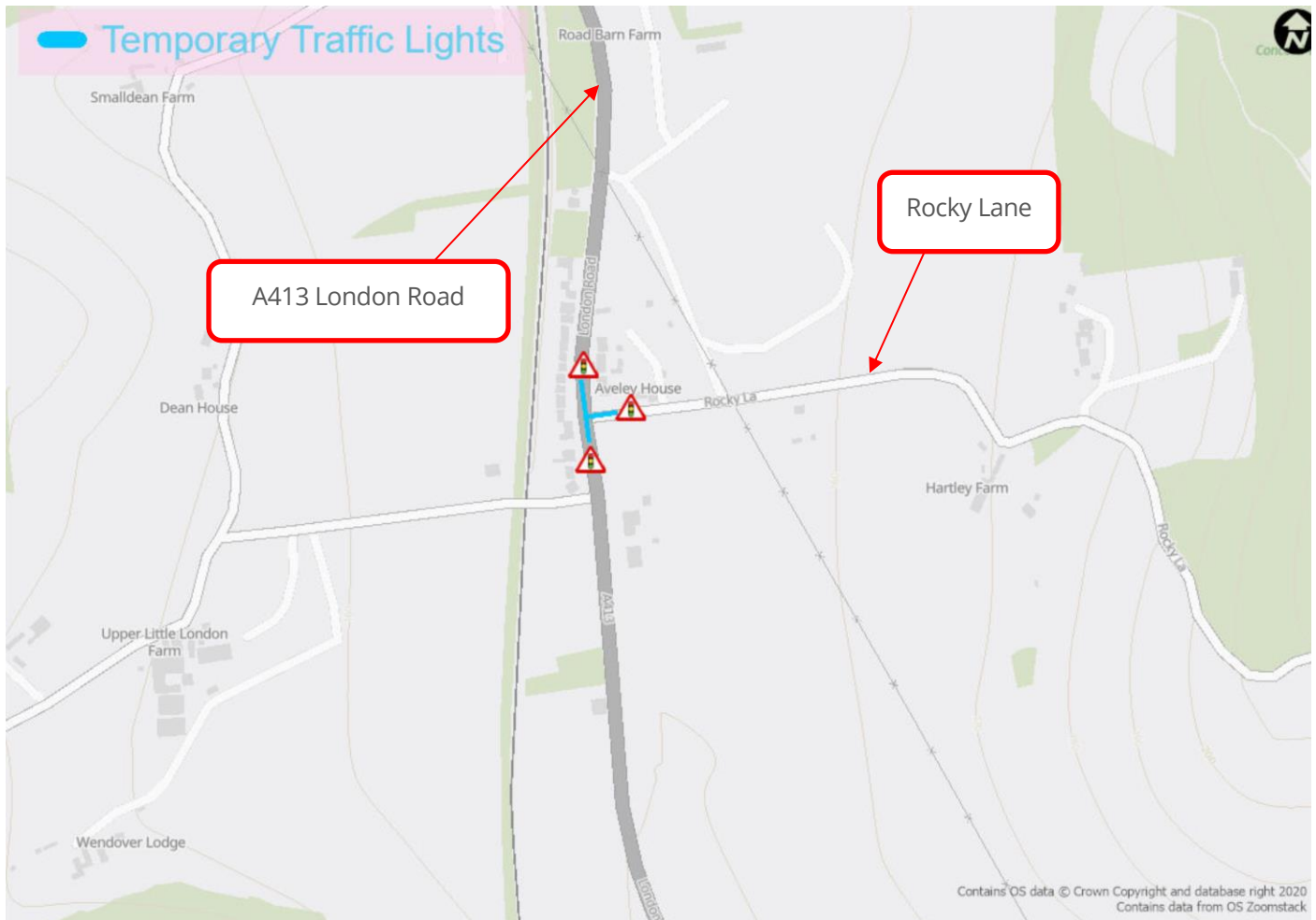
