



Notice of M42 M6 westbound link road overnight closures and diversion, near Water Orton

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be completing

To assist our ongoing construction activities for the M42 M6 link road viaducts, we will complete works to change the existing long term traffic management on the M42 M6 westbound link road. Currently road users are travelling along the hard shoulder. To continue our works safely, we will switch the traffic management to close the hard shoulder and allow access along lane two. The hard shoulder will also remain closed on the M42 M6 link southbound connector until Tuesday 1 August 2023.

In addition to this, we will carry out extra carriageway cleaning operations along the M42 M6 westbound link road. This cleaning programme will be in addition to the daily mitigation measures we have in place and will ensure that impact from our work to the highway is reduced as much as possible.

Traffic management

To complete the traffic management works safely, we will install two overnight closures on the M42 M6 westbound link road on Monday 12 June and Tuesday 13 June 2023. To complete the carriageway cleaning works, we will install a closure on the M42 M6 westbound link road on Friday 16 June. The closures will be in place from 9.00pm until 5.00am each night. Our contractors may be on site up to an hour before and after these times to set up and close down the site. The location of the road closure and diversion is shown on the map on page 2.

M42 M6 westbound link road overnight closures on 12 June and 13 June to switch traffic management

Hard shoulder to be closed and access via M42 M6 link road westbound to be maintained along lane two following the closures

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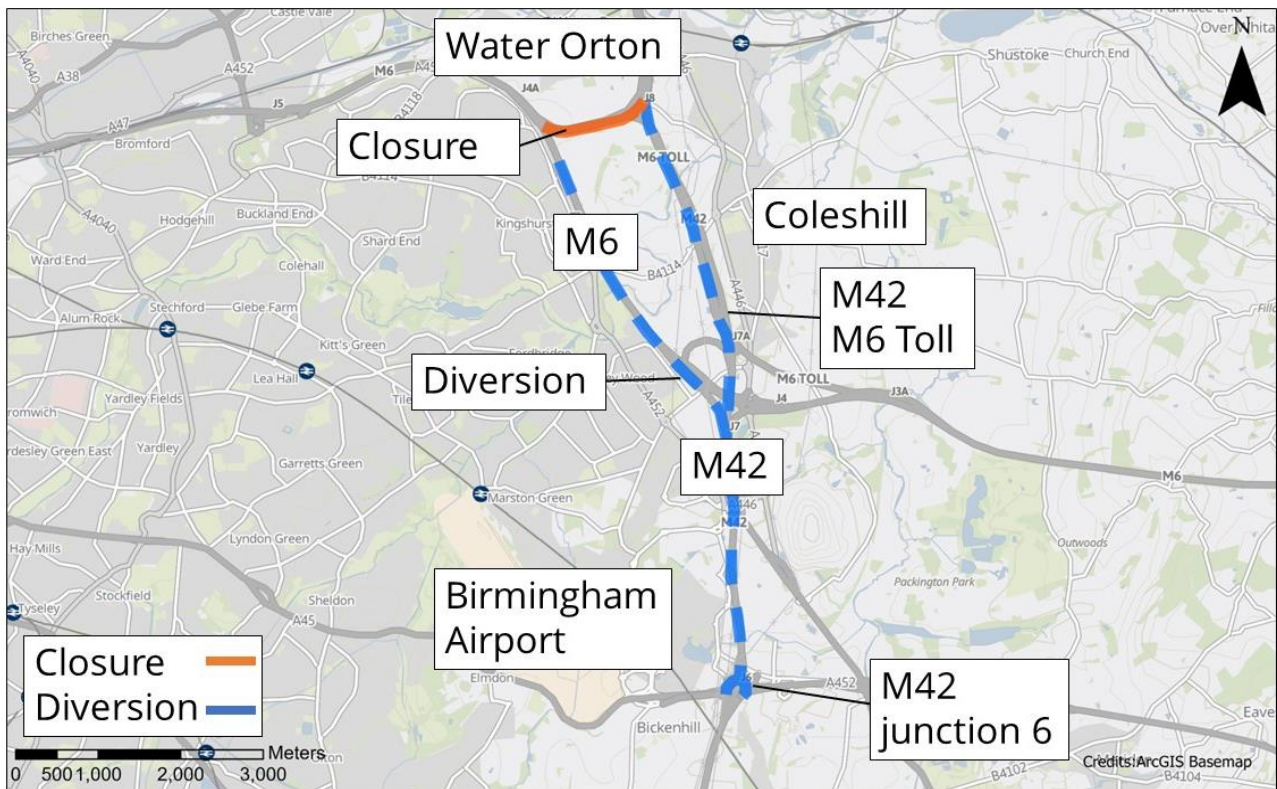

Throughout this closure a clear diversion route will be installed. Road users who wish to travel northbound can re-join the M42 at junction 6 to travel north and for those wishing to travel southbound on the M42 continue on their journeys.
