



## Notice of Traffic Management Programme Update, Gawcott Road/Perry Hill

### What are we doing?

At the end of May through to mid-June 2023, we will be working on a gas pipe underneath Gawcott Road/Perry Hill. These works were originally scheduled to start in mid-May. These works were delayed due to an issue encountered while working on the gas pipe which required revised consent to be granted by Southern Gas Network.

The gas pipe must be disconnected and decommissioned before the Gawcott Road/Perry Hill Bridge can be safely demolished this summer. These works are an important step towards the re-alignment of Gawcott Road/Perry Hill over the new bridge, currently under construction.

In order to carry out these works safely and effectively, two sections of Gawcott Road/Perry Hill will be under traffic management for approximately three weeks. This is for safety reasons, as our operatives will be working in open trenches on and around parts of the carriageway.

### When will these works take place?

Two sections of Gawcott Road/Perry Hill will be under traffic management from Tuesday 30 May and Sunday 18 June 2023. Three-way traffic lights will be located near the entrance of the Great Moor Sailing Club and two-way traffic lights near the entrance of the EKFB West Street Compound.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control, such as weather.

Two sections of Gawcott Road/Perry Hill will be under 24 hour traffic management from Tuesday 30 May to Sunday 18 June 2023:

- 3-way traffic lights near the Great Moor Sailing Club
- 2-way traffic lights near the entrance of the EKFB West Street Compound.

Varied activities with both quiet and busier periods.

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.


