UPDATE - Notice of works to complete new junction of A452/A446



High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area

UPDATE

We previously contacted you in May to inform you about our work to complete the junction of the A452/A446. Due to a change in the works programme these dates have changed. Please see the information below.

The work we will be doing

BBV have been significantly reconfiguring the junction of the A446 Stonebridge Road and A452 Chester Road near Birmingham Business Park to facilitate the construction of a bridge that will take the new railway over the M42. This summer we will be undertaking our final elements of work to complete the junction.

Element one

The first stage will consist of a full 24h closure of the southbound A452 Chester Road from the night of 7 June at 9:30pm until 15 June at 6am.

Element two

The second stage of this work will be overnight full closure of the A452 Northbound, outside of Birmingham Business Park. These closures will be in place from 9:30pm to 6am nightly from 7 June to 15 June.

Element three

The final stage of this work will comprise of 24 hour and night-time layouts in two separate locations.

The lay out of the 24h closure will continue the closure of the northbound carriageway of the A452 between the new roundabout (ROT) and the Northway Island, to enable us to build a new, smaller roundabout adjacent to Quartz Point. The northbound link to the A446 referred to as Biddle's Loop, will also remain closed. This road layout remains in place until 13 July.

Night-time from 19 June the northbound exit from A446 to A452 including the new link road to Birmingham Business Park will close. The closure will be in place until the 13 July. Traffic will be diverted via M6 J4 Roundabout. Please see maps.

Duration of works

Element one - 24 hours a day from 9:30pm on 7 June to 6am on 15 June.

Element two overnight only, from 7 June to 15 June, 9:30pm to 6am.

Element three

Daytime, 24 hours a day from 19 June until 13 July.

Night-time 19 June to 13 July 9:30pm until 6am.

What to expect

Low level noise from our work.

Fully signed diversion.

Short delay to journey times following diversion – allow 5 - 10 minutes.

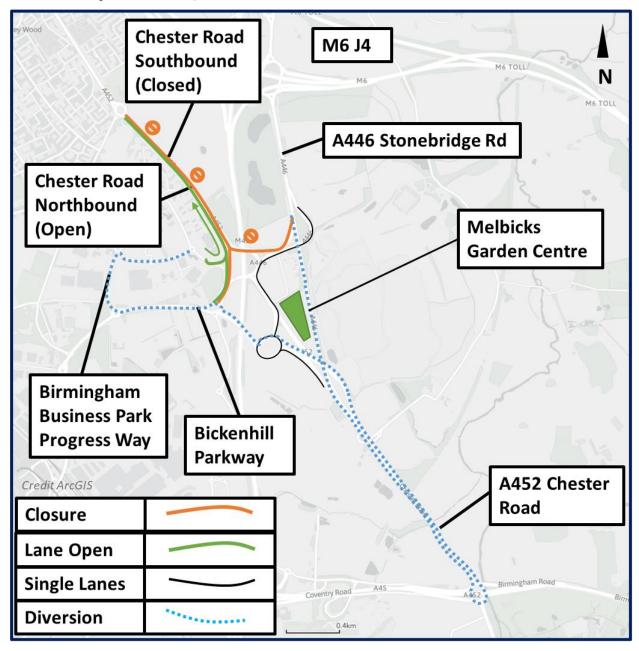

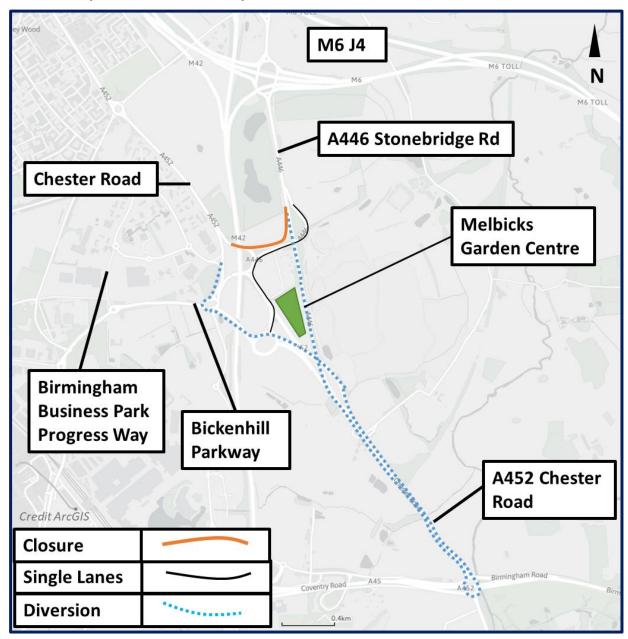

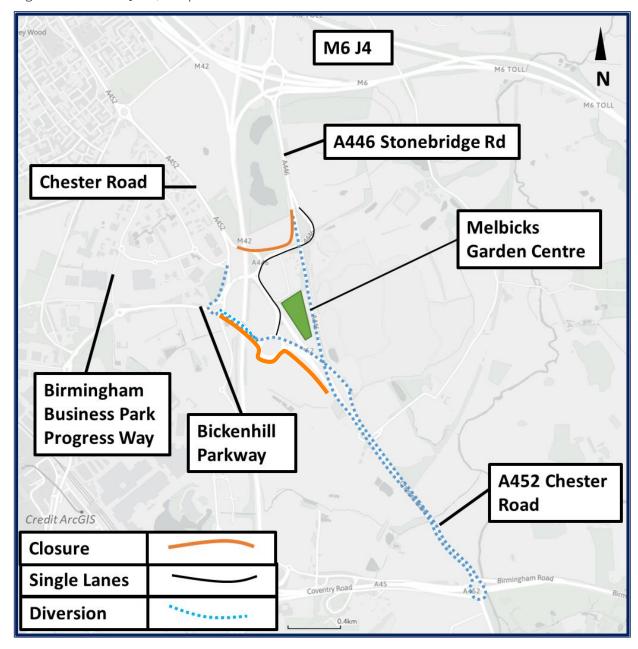
