Notice of Old Oak Common Lane road and footway night closure

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

Equipment delivery – Old Oak Common Lane

Our ongoing work at the Old Oak Common Station requires the delivery of a piece of oversized equipment to our site via Old Oak Common Lane. To avoid traffic disruption, the equipment will be delivered in the early morning on Tuesday 30 May between 1am and 4:30am.

For safety reasons, there will be a full road closure in place on Old Oak Common Lane, from Atlas Road Roundabout to Wells House Road for approximately two hours overnight between 1:30am and 3:30am. Please see the map on page two that shows the approximate location of the road closure.

Diversion routes will be signposted for local traffic and emergency services to Wells House Road and Oaklands Rise.

The operatives delivering the equipment will keep noise to a minimum and will only use hand signals to direct the vehicles.

Once the equipment arrives to site, it will be parked on site and then assembled during our normal working hours of Monday - Friday 8am -6pm and Saturday 8am -1pm.

We apologise for any disruption caused by these activities and we are working to minimise impacts as far as possible.

Duration of works

Full road closure for two hours overnight on Tuesday 30 May 2023, between 1am and 4:30am.

What to expect

Road diversion for the duration of the delivery of the equipment, sounds from vehicles and workers.

Full road closure on Old Oak Common Lane with no access for through traffic. A diversion route will be in place for local traffic to access Wells House Road and Oaklands Rise.

What we will do

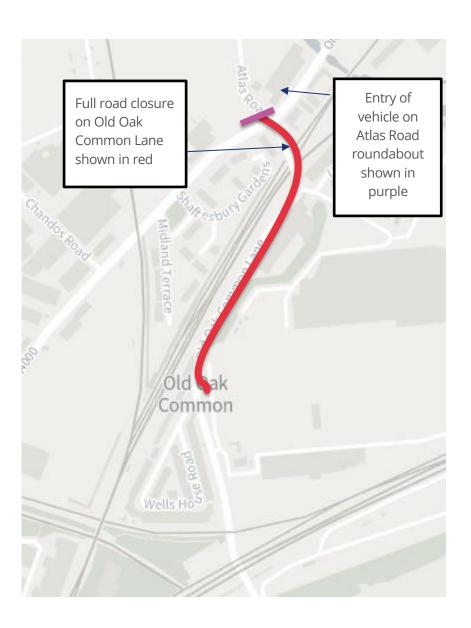
Operatives will keep noise to a minimum and only use hand signals. Provide a signposted diversion route.
