High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be completing

To continue our works for the M42 M6 Link Viaduct, we will complete works to change the existing long term traffic management on the M42 M6 westbound link road. Currently road users are travelling along the hard shoulder. To continue our works safely, we will switch the traffic management to close the hard shoulder and allow access along lane two.

Traffic management

In order to complete these works safely, we will install an overnight closure from 9.00pm on Friday 14 July until 5.00am on Saturday 15 July. Throughout the closure, a clear diversion route will be installed. Road users who wish to travel northbound can re-join the M42 at junction 6 to travel north and for those wishing to travel southbound on the M42 can continue their journey. The location of the diversion and closure is shown on the map below.
