High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. If you have any questions about these works, please contact our Helpdesk to find out more. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2inbucksandbox.co.uk.

What are we doing?

As part of our works for the diversion of a local water mains, our team need to work in open trenches along Church Lane and outside local properties. To carry out these works safely, we need to close the road along Church Lane in Mixbury. These works will take place in the daytime, during our core working hours. Where works allow, we will remove traffic management within the closure period when it is not required.

When will these works take place?

A section of Church Lane will be fully closed from Monday 4 September to Friday 29 September 2023. For reasons of safety and community concerns, the road will remain fully closed until these works are completed.

Works will take place Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm, and Saturday 8am to 2pm. There will be no Sunday working during these works.

Our aim is to keep the disruption to a minimum.

8am to 2pm

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.

What to expect

24-hour full road closure and some additional traffic for utility ground works. Full access to residents' properties on Church Lane. Varied activities with both quiet and busier periods.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

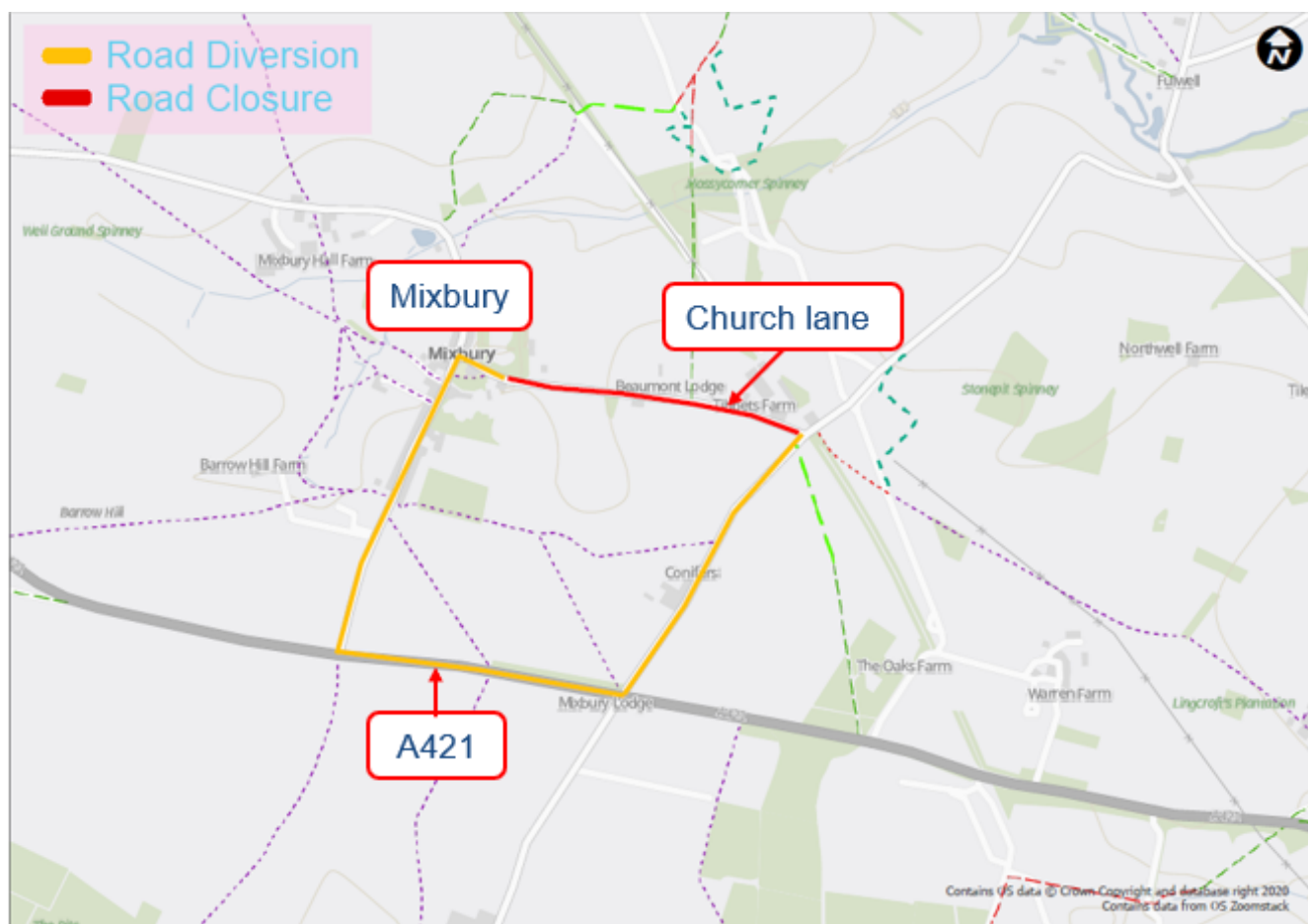
