

## Notice of road closure on The Broadway, and traffic management on A41

### What are we doing?

During July 2023, we will be carrying out overnight topographical surveys along a section of the A41 at the junction with The Broadway near Grendon Underwood. These surveys relate to highways along an approved route for heavy goods vehicles working on the HS2 project. They will be used to help inform possible design improvements to the junction in the future. These works were originally planned for the end of May and beginning of June.

A topographical survey is an exercise undertaken by land surveyors using highly specialised survey equipment. These surveys provide detailed maps of land, identifying both natural and man-made features within a specified area.

In order to complete these works, a section of The Broadway will be closed at the junction with the A41. There will also be temporary traffic management. This is for reasons of safety as our operatives will be working on and around the carriageway.

### When will these works take place?

From Monday 17 to Thursday 20 July 2023, a section of the A41 will be controlled by 2-way traffic lights and a section of The Broadway will be closed.

These dates may change due to conditions outside of our control. Please refer to the HS2 website regularly to check for any changes and updates.

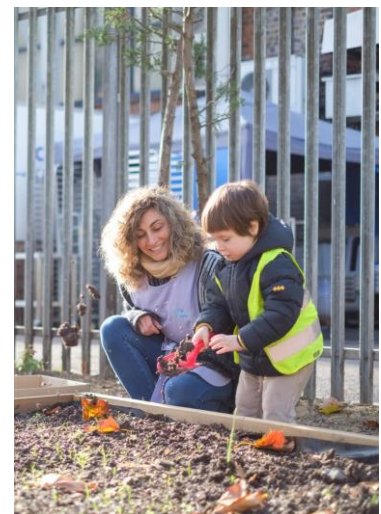
## About our Community and Business Funds
