What are we doing?

In July 2023, we will be continuing with utility diversion works on Station Road. This is in preparation for the upcoming realignment of Station Road.

We will be undertaking works to connect a water main along the southern section of Station Road at the junction with Quainton Road and Fiddlers Field/Snake's Lane.

In order to carry out these works safely and effectively, the junction of Station Road, Quainton Road and Fiddlers field/Snake's Lane will be under temporary traffic lights. This is for safety reasons, as our operatives will be working in open trenches on and around parts of the carriageway.

When will these works take place?

The junction of Station Road, Quainton Road and Fiddlers field/Snake's Lane will be controlled by 3-way temporary traffic lights from Monday 10 to Sunday 23 July 2023.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control, such as weather.

A section of Station Road at the junction with Quainton Road and Fiddlers Field/Snake's Lane will be under traffic management between Monday 10 July and Sunday 23 July 2023.

3-way traffic lights at the junction with Station Road, Quainton Road and Fiddlers Field/Snake's Lane.

Varied activities with both quiet and busier periods.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.
