

# Notice of road closure and temporary management, A413 London Road, Wendover

## What are we doing?

During the upcoming Network Rail engineering works on the Chiltern Rail line, we will be using the opportunity of the line closure to undertake works along the A413 London Road that support the construction of piers three and four of the Small Dean viaduct.

The activity will involve overnight road closures and temporary traffic lights during weekdays between 8.30pm and 5.30am. We are not planning to work through the weekends.

We have two phases of construction that will have short duration impacts on the road:

- The first phase of these works will require a full overnight road closure to transport materials into the area between the A413 and the Chiltern Rail line.
- The second phase will require temporary traffic lights while we construct piling platforms for the viaduct piers. These temporary traffic lights are required to enable our plant and vehicles to safely cross the A413 as required.

As you can see from the image on the following page, pier 3 of the viaduct is very close to the Chiltern Rail line. Construction of this piling platform can only take place during a closure of the line.

## When will these works take place?

Overnight road closures and traffic lights:

- Monday 31 July to Saturday 19 August (8:30pm to 5:30am)
- The road will be closed overnight during the first week and part of the second week. We will then switch to a traffic light system for the remaining duration.

To minimise disruption, we will provide a signposted diversion route and have chosen to work outside of peak traffic hours.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control.

Road closure and temporary traffic light hours of operation will be:

8.30pm to 5.30am

### What to expect

Full closure of part of the A413 London Road overnight for a short period.

Two-way temporary lights to enable plant and vehicles to safely cross the carriageway.

Various activities around the perimeter of the A413 and the Chiltern Rail line.

A fully signposted diversion route will be in operation throughout the closure period.

### What we will do

Respond promptly to any complaints we may receive and action accordingly.

Manage any noise or traffic impacts



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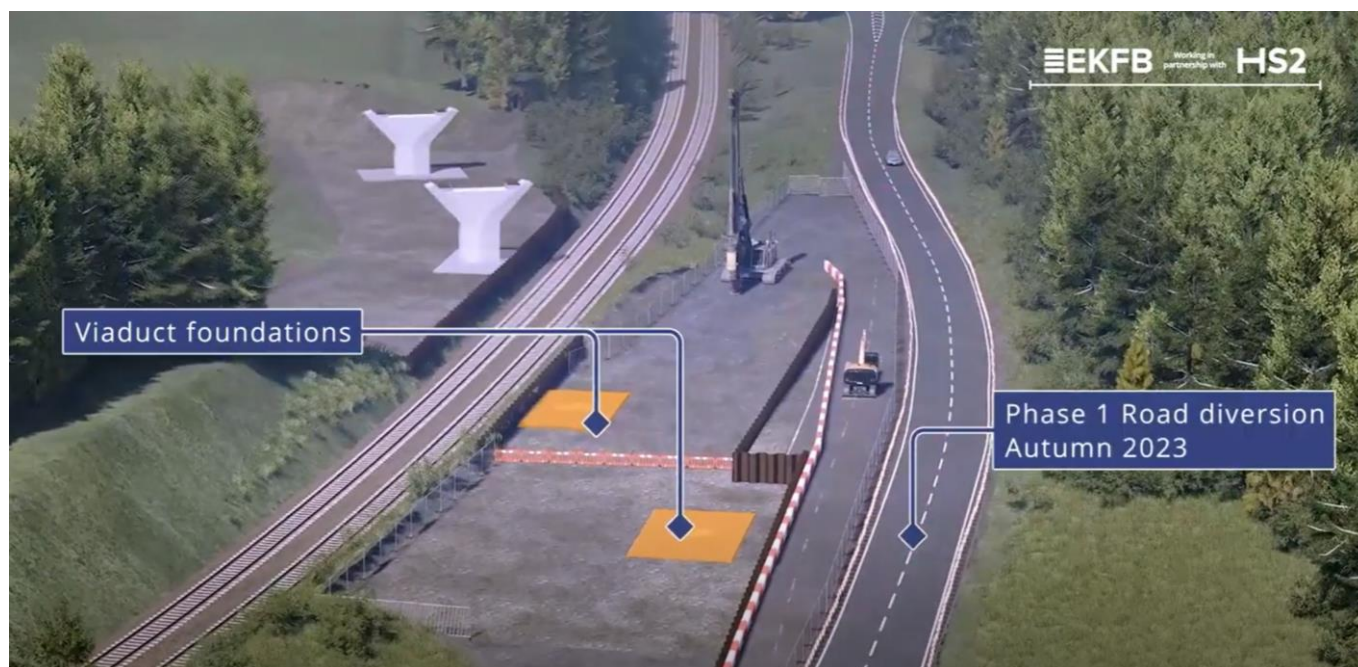


## Small Dean Viaduct construction phases video

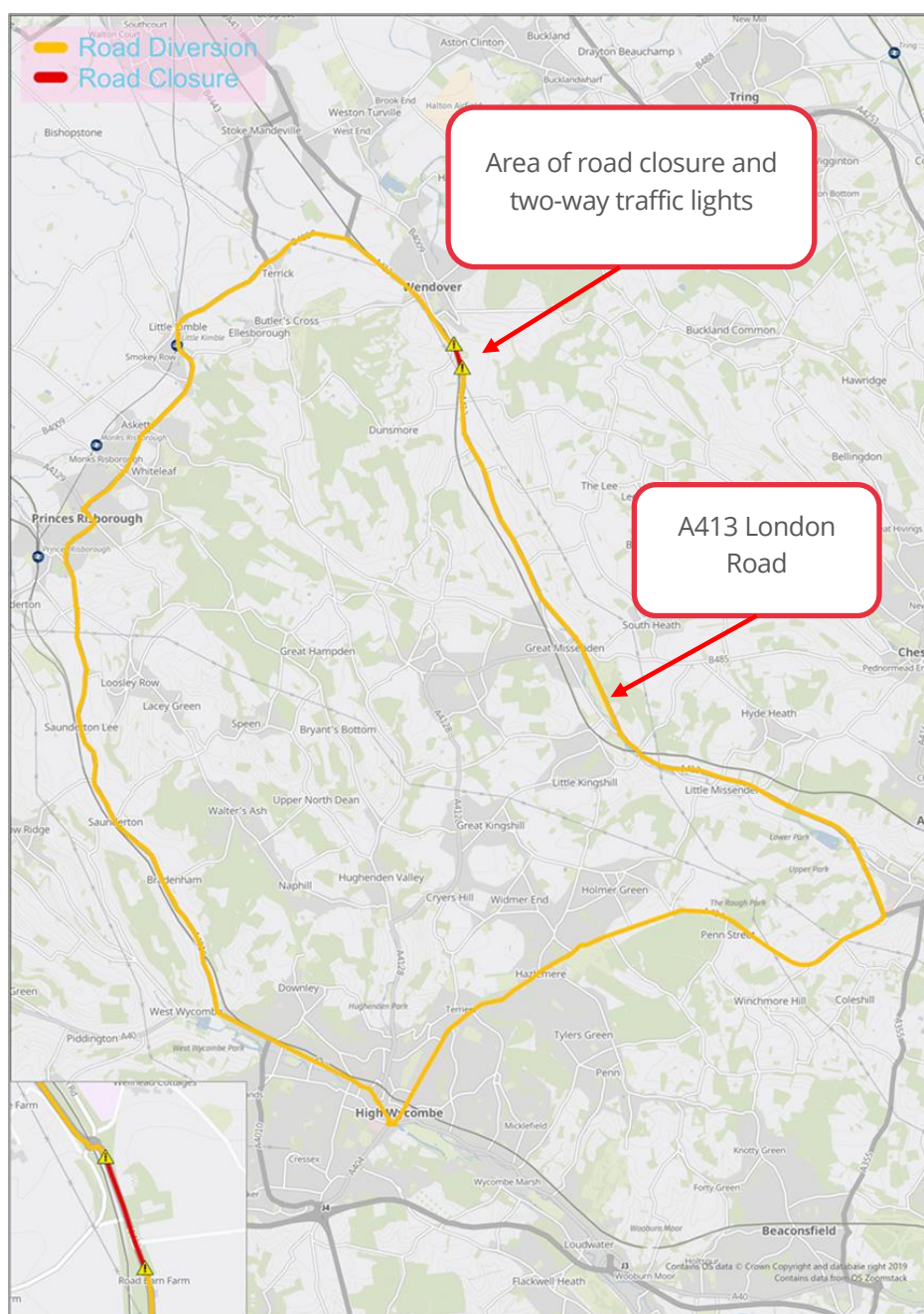


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## Where will the closures be?
