



# Notice of 24 hour works on the Birmingham to Derby trainline, near Coleshill

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

## The work we will be completing

To continue our works for the Curdworth Box, that will carry the railway over the existing trainline from Birmingham to Derby, we will complete works to install 25 metre long prefabricated beams. The location of this work is outlined on the map on page two.

To enable this work to be completed safely, blockades will be put in place throughout the works on the existing trainline from Birmingham to Derby.

## When we will do the work

We have been working with Network Rail to plan the blockades of the Birmingham to Derby line, near Coleshill. The blockades will be in place throughout three weekends including:

- Saturday 19 August until Monday 21 August
- Saturday 26 August until Monday 28 August
- Saturday 2 September until Monday 4 September

Throughout these weekends, we will complete works 24 hours a day, from 12.01am on Saturday mornings until 4.30am on Monday mornings.

## Curdworth Box

Once constructed, the Curdworth Box will be 15 metres in height, located near Hams Hall Distribution Park, to the north of Coleshill and will carry the HS2 railway line over the existing Birmingham to Derby trainline. The construction of the box has been built on site, either side of the existing trainline and a total of 175 piles will provide the foundations for the structure.

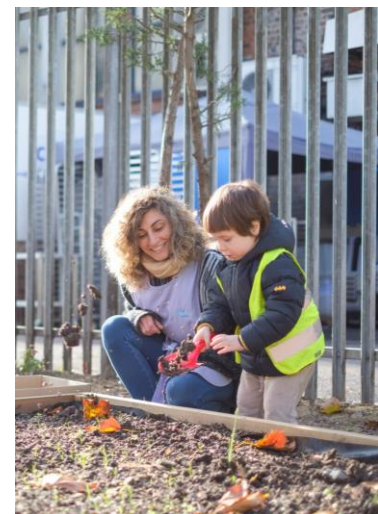
## About our Community and Business Funds
