Notice of UKPN Construction Works at Wilsden Euro-terminal

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

What are we doing?

From **14 August to 20 October 2023**, UK Power Networks (UKPN) will be carrying out electricity cable installation works within the Wilsden Euro-terminal (WET) site.

The electricity cable ducts will be installed by using heavy machinery to dig trenches before laying the cable ducts into the ground. The area will then be back filled and restored once the works have been completed.

How will this impact you?

UKPN will be working within the WET site, in the area highlighted on the map on page 2.

You will not be able to see our works but may be able to hear occasional excavation and backfilling noises if you are close to the site.

There will be no impact to your electricity supply.

If you are situated near the WET site, you may hear excavation and back filling noises. Access in and around the site will not be affected.

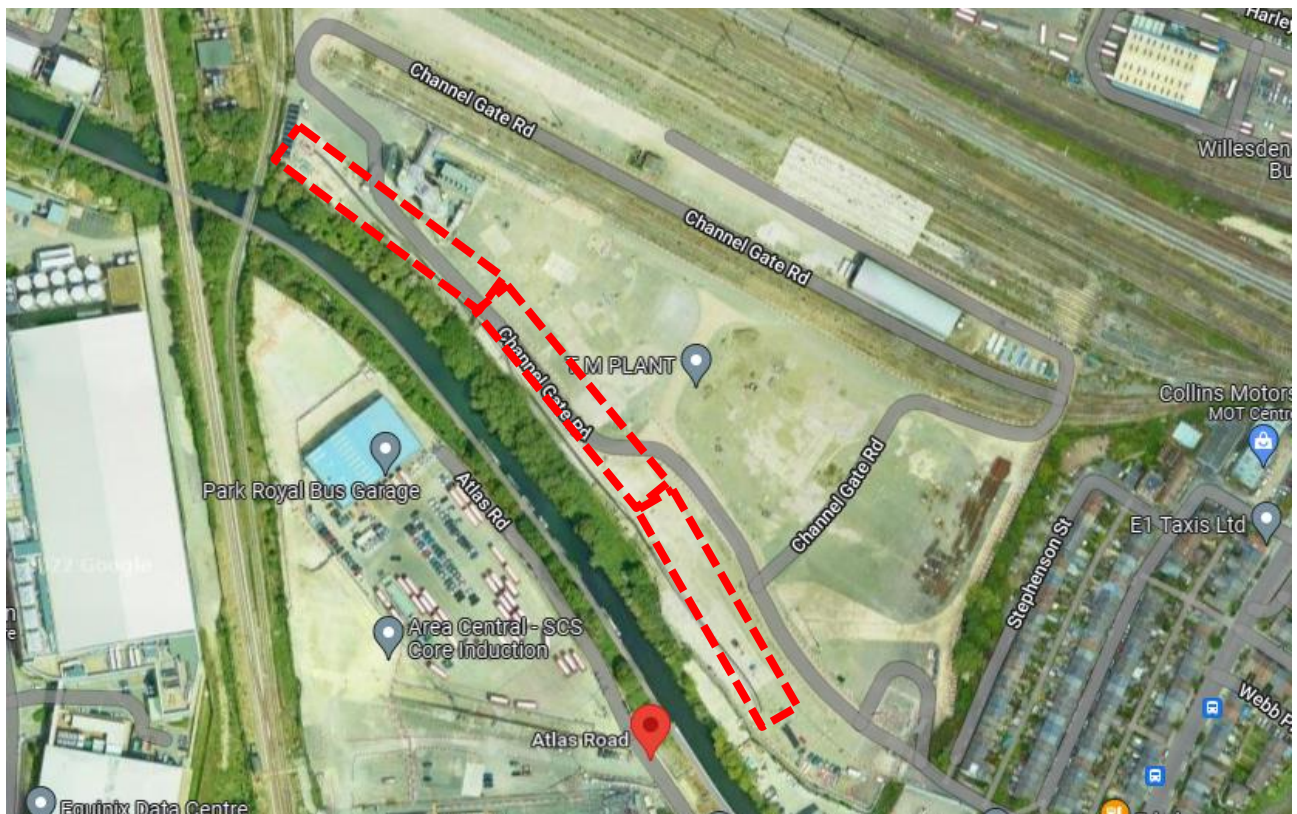
What we will do
