High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

To complete the re-alignment works of Stareton Lane, a section of Stareton Lane will be closed. To carry out the piling works for the new Stoneleigh Road overbridge and complete surfacing and lining works on the new Stareton Lane junction, we will require multi-way temporary traffic lights, and a section of Stoneleigh Road will need to be closed.

When will these works be taking place?

Updates on the time for the temporary traffic lights on Stoneleigh Road:

Stareton Lane will be closed from 14 August to 8 September 2023, with a diversion please refer to Map 1.

Stoneleigh Road will have temporary lights in place from 18 August 2023 8pm to 4 September 2023 8am, please refer to Map 2.

Stoneleigh Road will be closed from 4 to 8 September 2023, with a diversion please refer to Map 3.

Access to all properties will be maintained.

Our workforce maybe on site one hour before and one hour after to set up and secure our equipment.

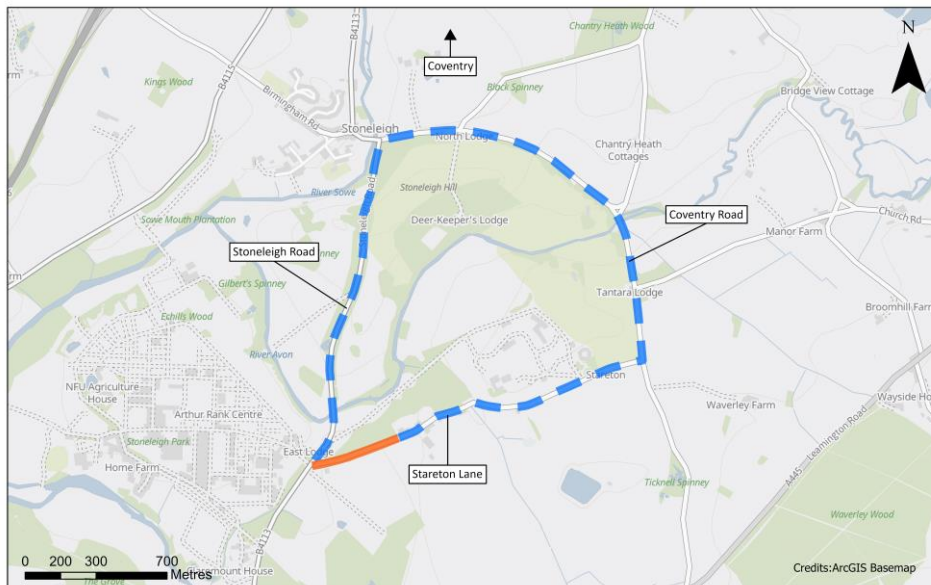

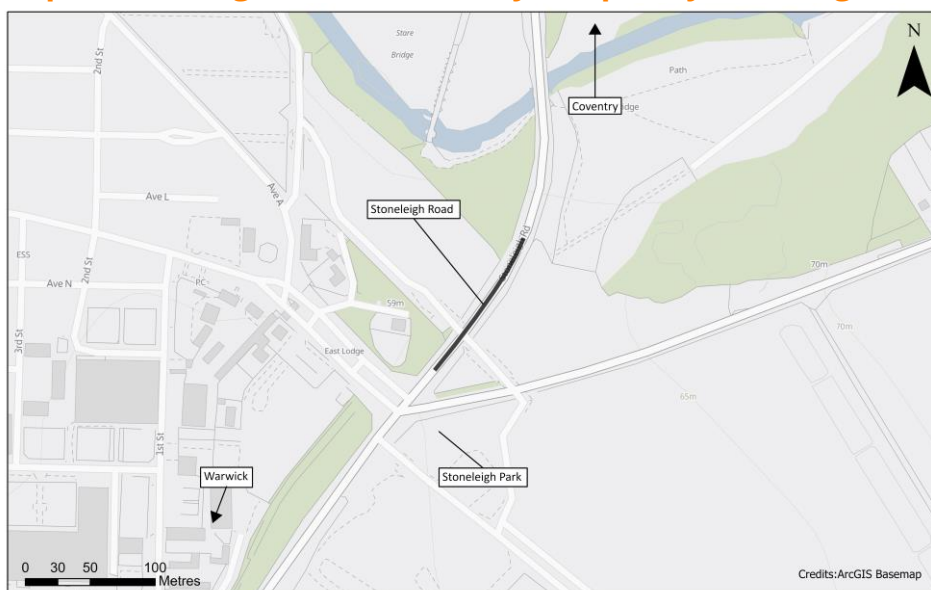
Map 1: Stareton Lane closure

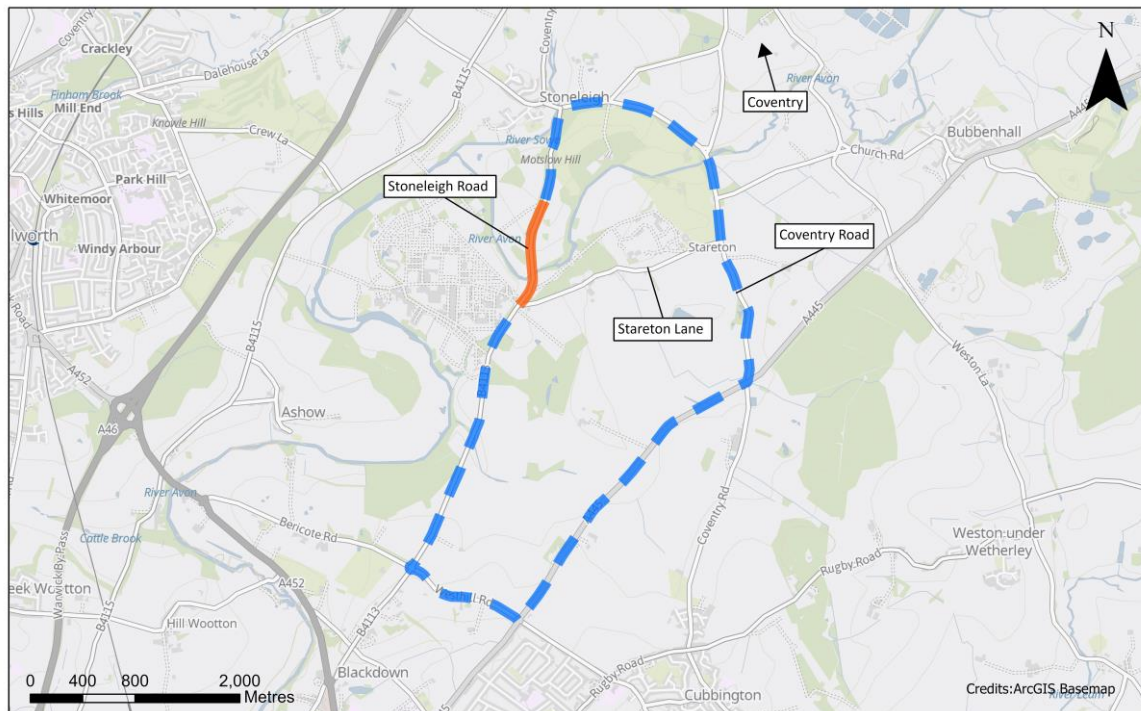
