# Notice of lane closure on A452 Kenilworth Road – Hampton-in-Arden

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

#### The work we will be doing

The new railway will pass under the A452 Kenilworth Road on a newly realigned section of road that is currently being built alongside the existing dual carriageway. The new section of road will 'tie in' to the existing road at a new roundabout that will be built near Lincoln Farm Truck stop. Before we start construction of this roundabout, we will need to drill a series of trial holes so that we can better understand the ground conditions in this area. To do this safely we will need to close one of the lanes on each side of the dual carriageway on 26 August until 1 September. The lanes will be closed 24 hours a day although we will only work during our normal working hours which are 8am-6pm Monday to Friday, 8am until 1pm on Saturdays and not at all on Sundays and Bank holidays.
