What are we doing?

In spring, we began works for the permanent realignment of the A423 Banbury Road Overbridge. This bridge will carry traffic over the HS2 railway line.

As part of these bridge preparations we will be installing ducting and cabling on the south verge near our plant crossing area on the A423 near Southam.

In order to safely carry out these works, there will be traffic management in the form of multi-way traffic lights for approximately two weeks this summer.

This may also include times when we need to hold the traffic for 15 minutes to complete work across the carriageway.

When will these works take place?

A section of the A423 Banbury Road will have traffic management from Friday 18 August to Sunday 27 August 2023.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control, such as poor weather.

Duration of works

The A423 will have multiway traffic lights from 18 August to 27 August 2023.

Normal working hours: Monday to Friday 8am - 6pm

Our contractors may be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown either side of these times.

What to expect

Traffic lights on a section of the A423 for two weeks.

Access will be maintained for residents and emergency services.

What we will do

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

Take care to respect the community.

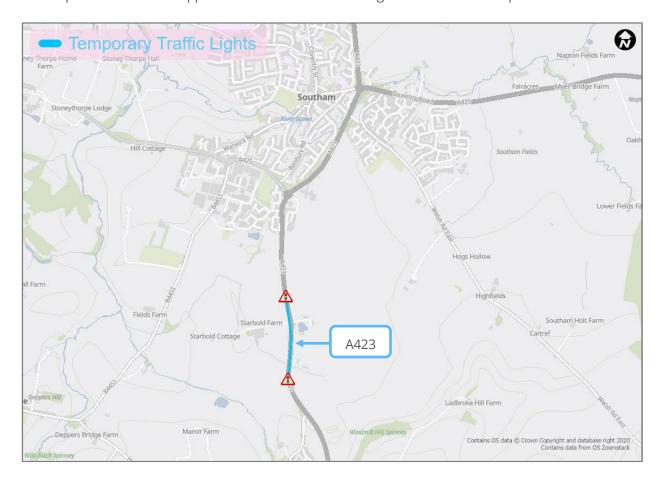
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Where will the works take place?
