



## Notice of road closure, Banbury Road, Boddington

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. EKFB is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at [www.hs2.org.uk/in-your-area](http://www.hs2.org.uk/in-your-area)

### What are we doing?

We are building new sections of road to connect the Banbury Road Overbridge to Banbury Road and Warwick Road in Boddington. Much of this work so far has been completed without affecting the flow of traffic along the highway, but from late August, a series of road closures will be required.

The work involves realigning Banbury Road and Wormleighton Road to meet the same height as the bridge that crosses the HS2 railway. Due to the significant earthworks required, it will not be safe or practical to keep these roads open while this work is in progress.

From late August, a section of Banbury Road will be closed for approximately 12 weeks to carry out this work. Temporary traffic lights will be in use prior to this, from mid August, as we prepare for the road closure.

In October, we will be connecting a new section of highway to Wormleighton Road. This will require Wormleighton Road to close for approximately 4 weeks. We will publish further information when the start date for this closure is confirmed.

On page 3 is a summary of our future work in this area, including the construction of Stoneton Lane Green Overbridge.

### When will these works take place?

A section of the Banbury Road will be fully closed, 24-hours a day, from Tuesday 29 August to mid November 2023. Signed diversion routes will be in place. In order to minimise disruption, Warwick Road and Banbury Road will not be closed at the same time.

This work is subject to local authority consents and approvals.

A section of Banbury Road will be fully closed from Tuesday 29 August 2023 to mid November 2023.

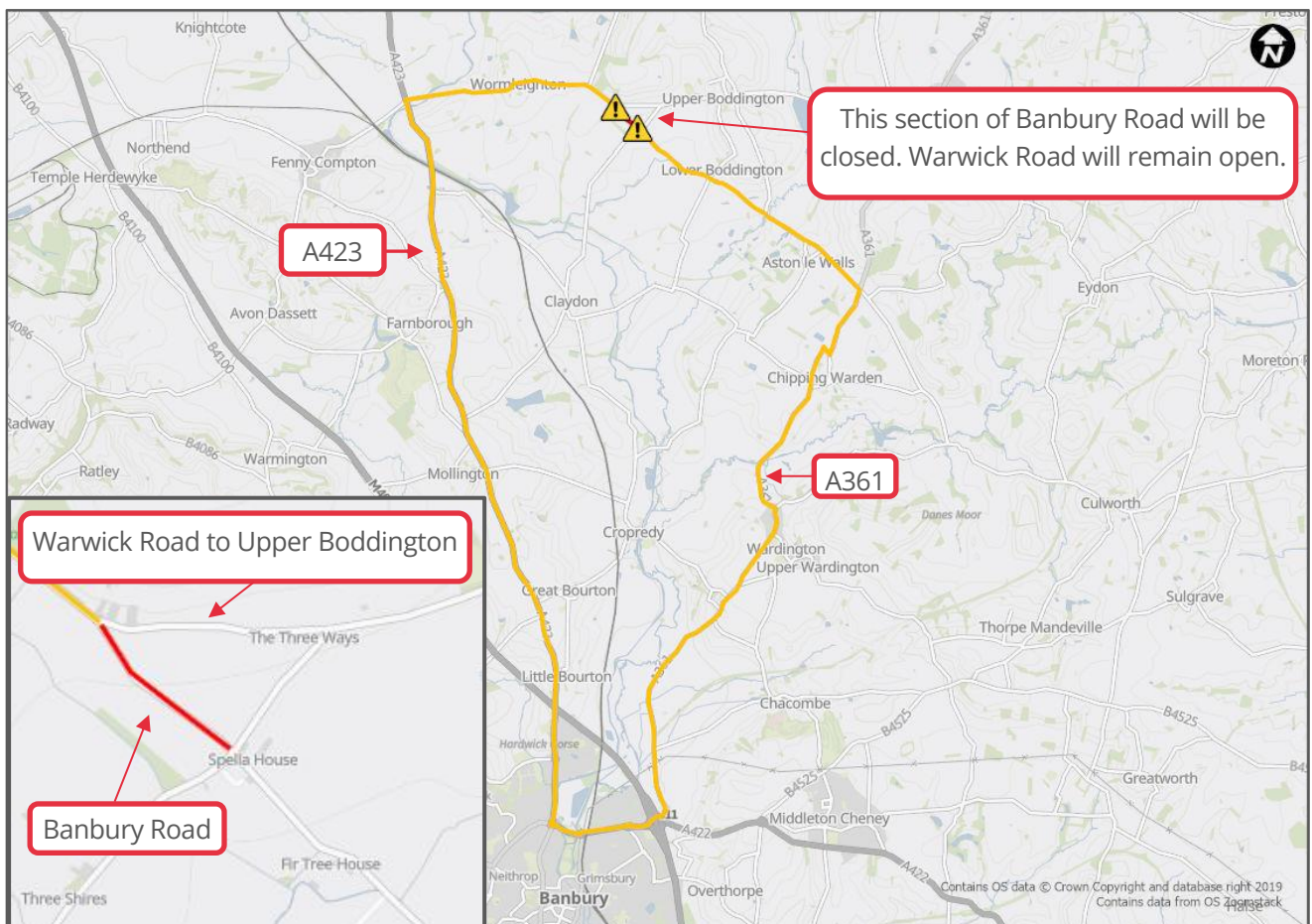

## Where will the works take place?

**Tuesday 29 August to mid November 2023**

The map below shows the section of Banbury Road that will be fully closed 24-hours a day, and the diversion route. Nearby businesses will be open as usual during this closure period. Prior to this, temporary traffic lights will be in use on Banbury Road, from mid August, as we prepare this section of road for the closure.

## Further construction from autumn 2023

### Mid October to mid November 2023: Wormleighton Road

The map below shows, how during October 2023, there will be a closure of both Banbury Road and Wormleighton Road. Once the work here is complete the roads will be realigned and begin to use new bridge.



### Mid November 2023 to mid December: Warwick Road

Once work is completed on Banbury Road and Wormleighton Road, the new bridge will be open to traffic from the Wormleighton to Boddington area. At this point a section of Warwick Road will close while we join it to the new road network by the Banbury Road Overbridge.

### Mid November 2023 to the end of 2025: Stoneton Lane

Once the new Banbury Road Overbridge is open to traffic, access to Stoneton Lane from Banbury Road will not be possible. At this time we will begin to excavate the railway cutting and to construct the Stoneton Lane Green Overbridge, which will take approximately 18 to 24 months to complete. Once built the Stoneton Lane Green Overbridge will connect Stoneton Lane to Wormleighton Road over the railway.

**We will publish further details when start dates for the above road closures are confirmed.**
