



Temporary traffic lights on Chesham Road, B485, **Buckinghamshire**

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. This notice is to inform you of temporary lights on Chesham Road B485, in South Heath, Buckinghamshire, to install instrument and monitoring equipment for our tunnelling works.

How will these works affect you?

Four-way traffic lights will be in place on Chesham Road, B485, so we can safely work in the highway. We will use temporary traffic lights to narrow the road and keep traffic flowing.

The temporary traffic lights will be in place daily from:

- 21 August 24 August
- 10am to 3pm.

What will we be doing?

A small team of engineers will be visible on the highway whilst they install monitoring equipment. To do this safely, there will be a lane closure on a small section of Chesham Road, B485.

Why are we doing these works?

The monitoring equipment is being installed in preparation of the passage of the TBMs. Monitoring surveys are carried out along the highway as it is a hard surface that provides an accurate reading. We need to obtain this above surface as well as below ground, from vent shaft to vent shaft, to ensure correct alignment of the Chiltern tunnel.



The team may be visible in the area early in the morning. The temporary lights will not come into effect until 10am and will end at 3pm, when the traffic management will be removed.
