Notification about railway work in the Euston Station area: December 2023 – February 2024:

Work is continuing to bring some of the work for HS2 in the Euston area to a safe stop whilst other vital work that needs to continue in preparation for High Speed 2 (HS2) that cannot be paused will continue. To keep our staff safe, we may need to work at times that cause the least disruption to train services and passengers which can include weeknights and weekends. We're sorry if our work disturbs you. We'll make every effort to reduce disturbance where we can. We'll put noise barriers up where it is safe to do, use silenced generators and have continuous noise monitoring to ensure that noise levels are kept within agreed limits. Our staff will also be regularly briefed on the importance of working responsibly in the local community.

HS2 On Network Works, MDjv and SCS will close down their work between 23/12/2023 and 02/01/2024.

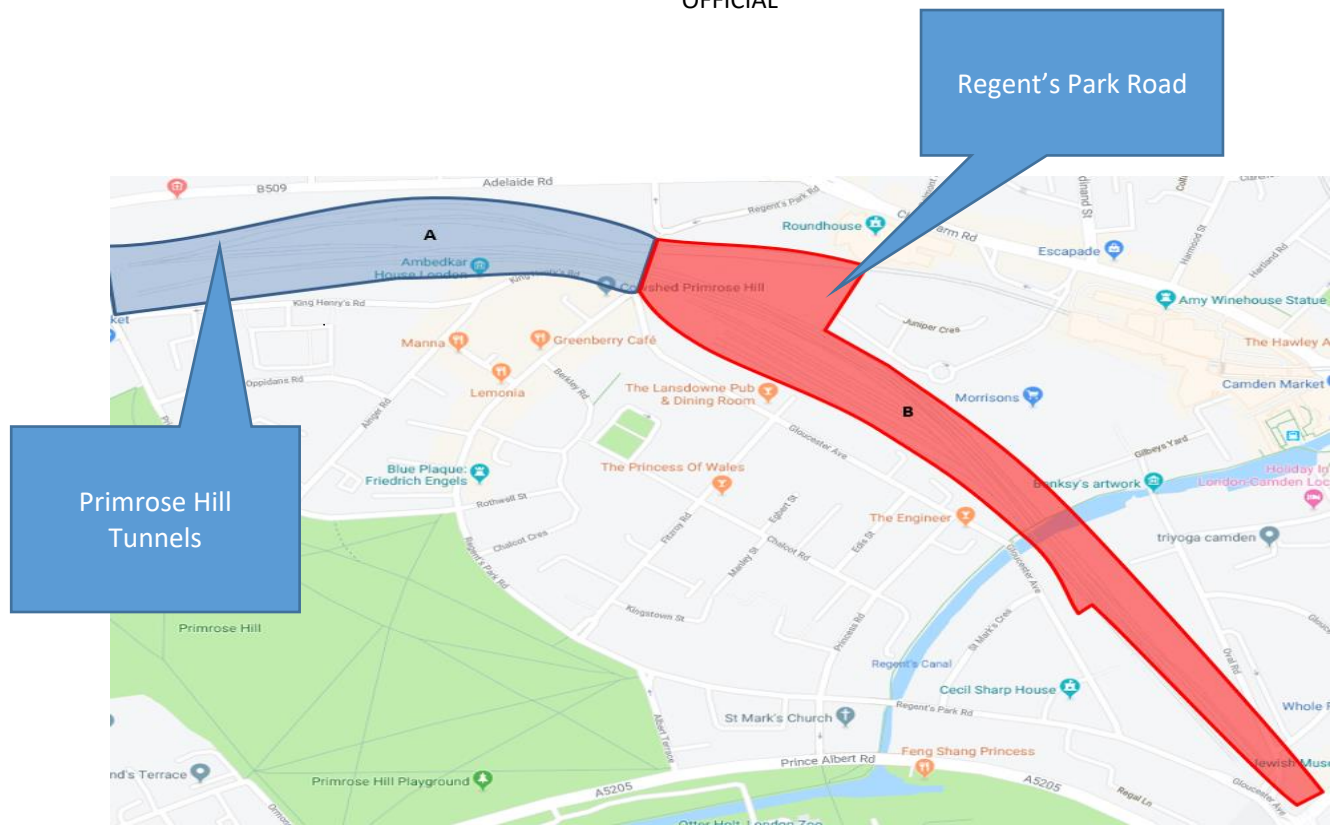

Mornington Street Bridge (road closure)

Network Rail and HS2 are working together to reopen Mornington Street bridge to vehicles as soon as possible. This will be until tunnelling work begins (now planned to be in 2026).

We expect Mornington Street bridge to be reopened by early 2024. The bridge will be opened with a 3-tonne weight limit in place. We will manage the weight limit by placing width restriction barriers at both ends of the bridge. The bridge signs will be replaced in the area to notify road users of the new 3-tonne weight limit. For safety reasons, Network Rail and SCS will continue to monitor the bridge whilst work continues beneath it.

SCS and MDjv will continue to provide residents with advance notice of construction impacts before they begin works.



Network Rail will continue to do planned maintenance work overnight on sections of the railway, due to the nature of this work it would be impractical to notify residents of every piece of work we do. We do send notifications of major work.
