High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. This notice is to inform you of a series of overnight closures of the A412 North Orbital Road near Denham in September.

Overnight road closures on the A412 in Denham, Buckinghamshire

AlignJV is building the 3.4km Colne Valley Viaduct and is now just over a kilometre on its journey from the North Embankment at Denham in Buckinghamshire to the South Embankment near Harvil Road in Hillingdon. The decking of the viaduct over the A412 has already been completed however we now need to work over the road to install parapets – walls either side of the viaduct. We have already installed some of these either side of the A412, as illustrated below, but to do the sections safely over the public highway we need to close the road to all users. For the safety of pedestrians and road users during the works, the A412 will be closed to pedestrians and all through traffic between Chalfont Lane, West Hyde and Moorfield Road, Denham Green - Monday to Saturday, from Monday 4 September to Friday 29 September between 10pm and 5am.



We need to install 48 parapets on the short section of viaduct deck over the A412. In total there are over 1500 parapets needed for the entire length of the viaduct.

Duration of works

Monday 4 September to Friday 29 September 2023. Works are taking place overnight 10pm to 5am Monday to Saturday

What to expect

Overnight closure on the A412 in both directions near to Denham Water Ski Club

Some noise and additional lighting

These works are weather dependent, so dates may need to change

What we will do

Marshalled and signed access for residents and businesses

Signed diversion for traffic on local diversion route

If for any reason we are not working, we will not close the road that evening.

How will this affect me?

Please see the map below for the location of the diversion route to be used during the overnight road closures. The diversion will be fully signed and managed at both ends of the closed section. Access will be maintained to premises in the exclusion zone. Otherwise no access will be permitted through the actual closure point for non-works traffic. There is also no pedestrian access. We aim to complete the work as quickly as possible, however it is weather dependent, and we may need to work overnight from Saturday into Sunday morning if we fall behind.

Further updates will be provided if the timing of these works change. If we are unable to work overnight, we will reopen the road and notify road users using digital road signs placed at either end of the A412 exclusion zone.


Drop in event

If you are interested or concerned about the road closures, or any other aspect of the Colne Valley Viaduct construction, please do visit us at our “drop in” meeting at Harefield Community Centre, Priory Avenue, Harefield on Tuesday 15 August 2023 between 3:30pm and 7pm.

Access for residents and businesses between 10pm and 5am

We understand that the closure may inconvenience residents, businesses, pedestrians and other road users, but for your safety and those undertaking the works, we cannot allow pedestrians or road users to pass under the viaduct whilst the parapets are being installed by the crane. However, access for residents and businesses between Maple Cross and the north end of the road closure will be carefully managed, as it will be from the south end of the road from Denham Green. Access for pedestrians across the A412 to and from the existing Public Rights of Way DEN/P1/1 and DEN/P38/1 will also be closed from 10pm to 5am during the works.

Advanced warning signs will be in place at either end of the closure. Below is a map of the exclusion zone. Access will be maintained for residents in Denham Green, Denham Garden Village, Denham Film Studios and West Hyde.
