High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

To continue our construction in the area, we will be undertaking works on the M42, M6 link road, on the eastbound and westbound carriageways. The work we will complete involves delivering plant and machinery and extra carriageway cleaning. This cleaning programme will be in addition to the daily mitigation measures we have in place and will ensure that impact from our work to the highway is reduced as much as possible.

When we will do the work

To ensure the safety of the road users and our workforce, we will install overnight closures of both the eastbound and westbound carriageways on the M42, M6 link road from 9pm to 5am each night. See below a breakdown of these overnight closures:

M42 eastbound

- Thursday 7 September to Friday 8 September
- Tuesday 12 September to Wednesday 13 September
- Friday 29 September to Saturday 30 September

M42 westbound

Friday 15 September to Saturday 16 September

Our workforce may be on-site up to one hour before and after to set up and secure our equipment.

Eastbound closure and diversion

Road users will follow the M6 southbound until junction 4, then via the A446 and A452 southbound. Following this, road users will be able to follow the A45 westbound to the M42.



Westbound closure and diversion

Road users who wish to travel northbound can re-join the M42 at junction 6 to travel north and for those wishing to travel southbound on the M42 can continue their journey.
