# Notice of traffic management on the A5 Hints Bypass

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

### The work we will be doing

We will be commencing construction of the A5 Overbridge that will allow HS2 to pass under the A5. We are working with National Highways minimise the impact on road users while we construct the bridge and have created a temporary diversion on land next to the A5. Once completed we will divert traffic onto the new temporary road which will minimise future disruption and closures of the A5.

#### This work will be completed using phased traffic management:

**Phase 1**- Installing speed cameras on the A5 Hints Bypass.

To install the speed cameras, we will have:

- Overnight closures of the A5 eastbound carriageway from 2
  October to 4 October 2023 between 9pm and 5.30am.
- Overnight closures of the A5 westbound carriageway on 5, 6 and 9 October 2023 between 9pm and 5.30am.

Our workforce may be on-site up to one hour before and after to set up and secure our equipment.

See below details of the following two phases of work. We are awaiting confirmation and consents for this work. When these works are confirmed, we will share an updated communication.

Phase 2 - Reducing speed limits and lane closures.

To enable us to switch the traffic onto the new temporary road we will be reducing the speed limit on the A5 from 60mph to 40mph and closing a lane on each carriageway along a section of the A5.

### The work we will be doing

**Phase 3-** Switching traffic from the current A5 Hints Bypass onto the new temporary road. This will be done in stages.

- 1- We will have temporary closures of the eastbound and westbound carriageways to complete the connection with the new temporary road. We will maintain traffic flows by moving traffic across each carriageway to keep one lane running in each direction.
- 2- Overnight carriageway closures will be used to move traffic onto the new temporary road. The temporary road will be in operation until Winter 2025.
- 3- Once the temporary road is open we will commence piling works and will construct the Overbridge. Once construction of the Overbridge is complete we will reconstruct the A5 carriageway and move traffic back onto it. We will then remove the temporary road and traffic will be back to normal.


