What are we doing?

In July we closed the A413 London Road over a weekend to divert a watermain across the road in preparation for the temporary realignment of road later this year. This realignment is taking place to enable us to construct piers three and four of the Small Dean Viaduct.

To complete this important utility diversion and to ensure water pressure is maintained in the local area we need to close the A413 consecutively overnight from the 2 October until 14 October.

The works we will undertake is the digging of a trench diagonally across the road each night to access the pipework and back filling again before we open the road each morning.

The activity will involve overnight road closures on weekday nights, we are not planning to work over the weekend.



When will these works take place?

The overnight road closures will be installed between 8.30pm and 5.30am from Monday 2 October to Saturday 14 October.

To minimise disruption, we will provide a signposted diversion route and have chosen to work outside of peak traffic hours.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control.

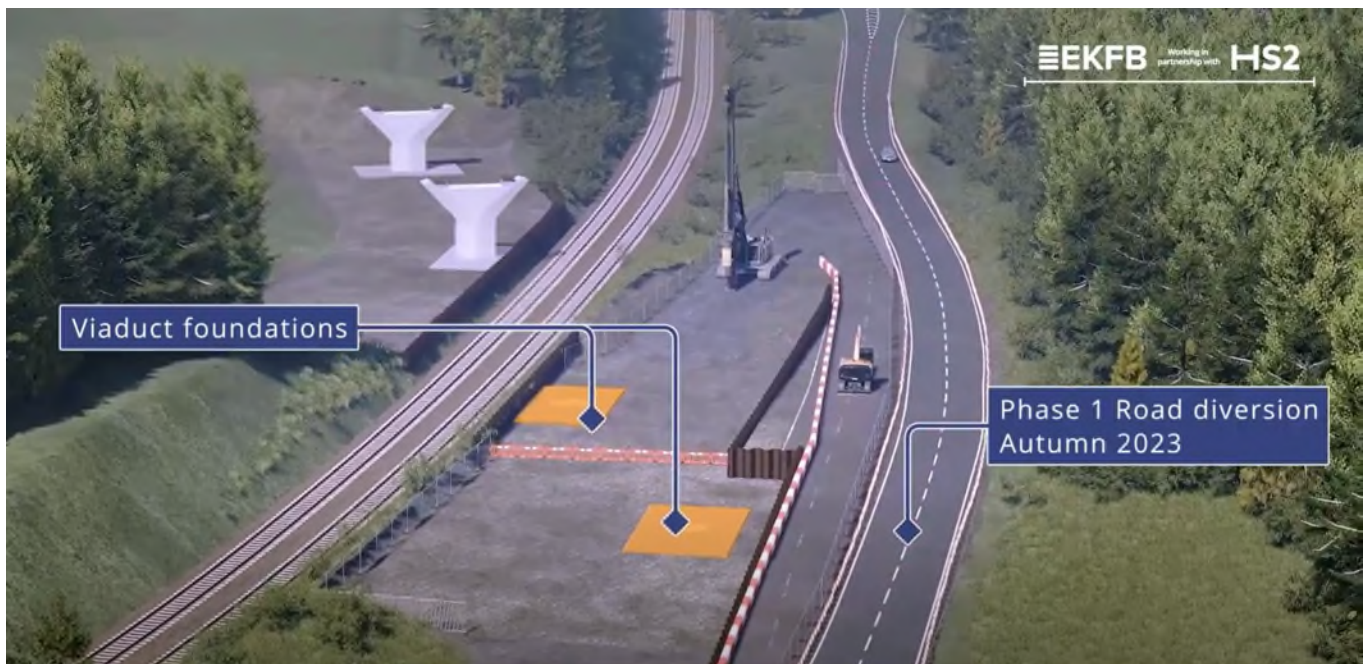


Small Dean Viaduct construction phases video

To help you understand exactly what work we will be carrying out around the A413 and why it is required, we have produced a video using our 4D design model demonstrating upcoming work for the construction of Small Dean Viaduct including road diversions and utility work.

Above in the yellow highlighted squares you can see the locations of the piers which we will be constructing and their close proximity to the live Chiltern Line.

In this location we are also introducing a plant crossing to enable our team to import plant and materials into this area in order for us to be able to construct piers 3 and 4 of the viaduct.

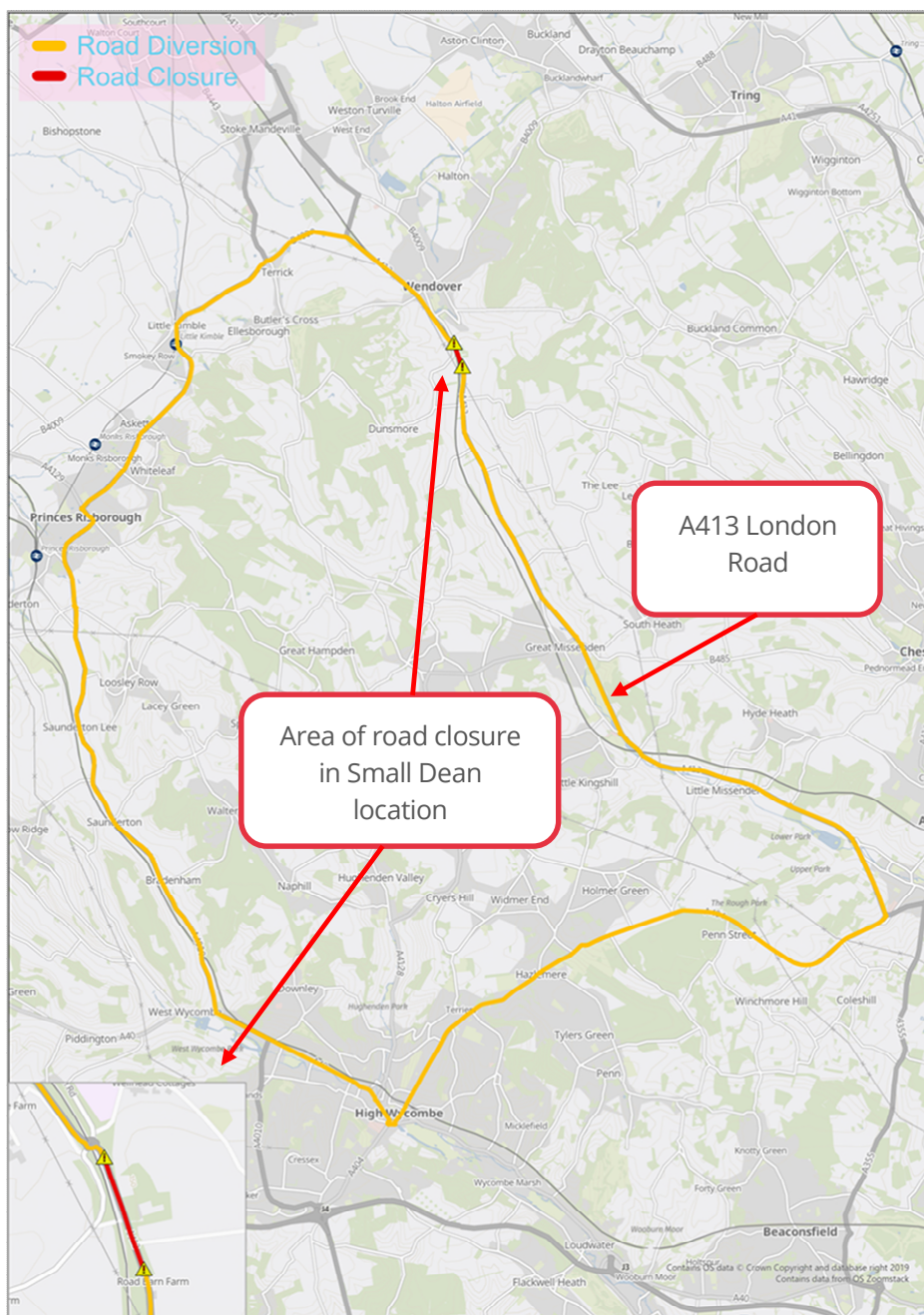
