

## Notice of traffic lights on A425, Leamington Road, Southam

### What are we doing?

EKFB are building a permanent road for maintenance access to the railway along the A425 Leamington Road in Southam.

During October we will be carrying out some de-vegetation and preparation works for a new access road.

To carry out these works, the A425 will have traffic management in the form of a single lane closure with two-way traffic lights for approximately one week in October.

During this time there will be occasions when we will need to work across the road, traffic may be held at the lights for no more than 15 minutes to ensure a safe working area.

### When will these works take place?

The short section of the A425 Leamington Road will have traffic management from Monday 9 October to Saturday 14 October 2023, from 8am to 6pm.

These dates may be subject to local authority consents and may change due to circumstances outside of our control, such as weather.

Access will be maintained for residents as well as emergency services within the closure area.

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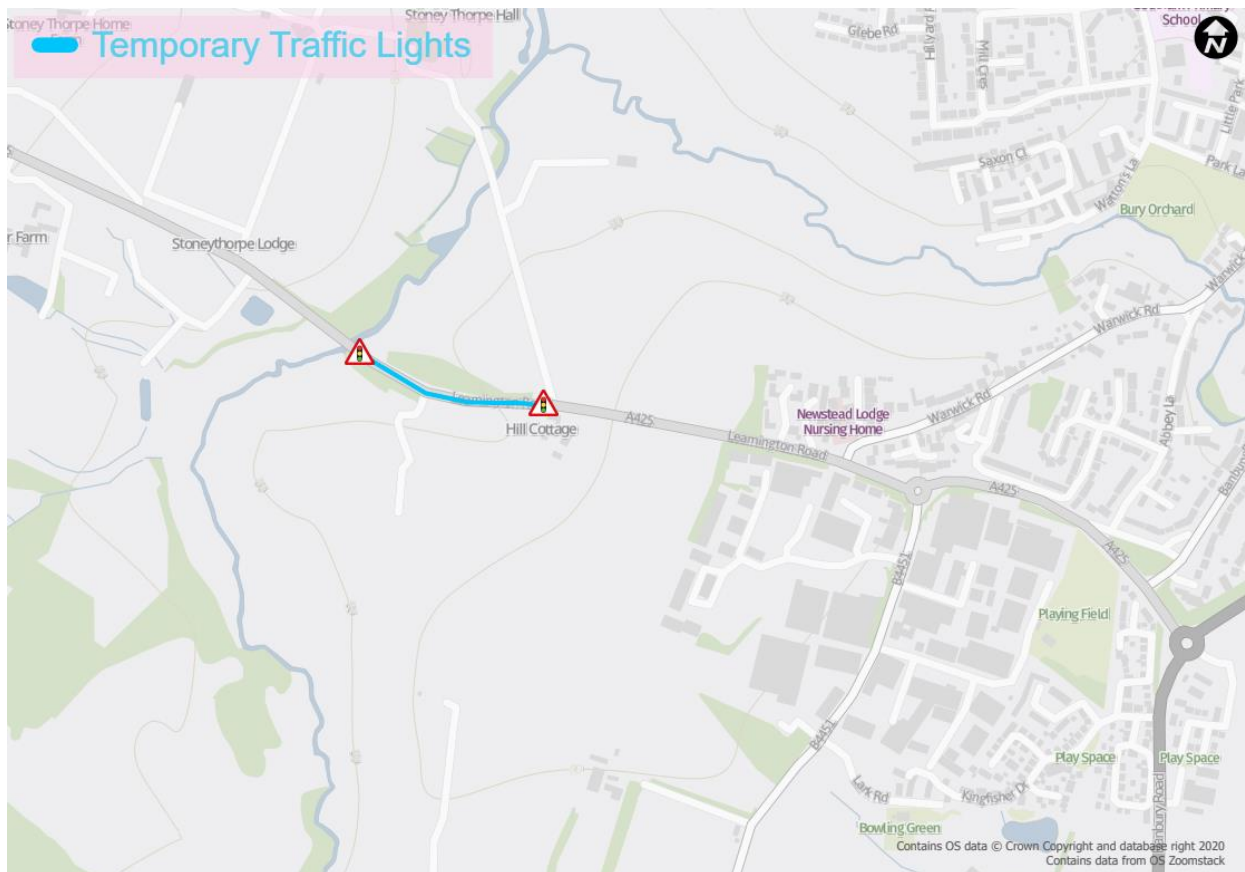
